That proper movable barricades (and lights, if necessary) will be furnished by the group and properly placed and removed by them.</li><li>3. That the streets and sidewalk area used will be cleared of all debris at the conclusion of the event.</li><li>4. That no loud band, stereos, radios or like equipment will be used.</li><li>5. That one side of the street be kept clear in case any emergency vehicle (fire, ambulance, police) must enter the barricaded area.</li><li>6. That the party will be over with and the streets cleared and open to all traffic no later than <b><u>DUSK</u></b>.</li></ol>
