Dear Resident:

The City will begin construction of a new traffic signal and roadway improvements near the intersection of Red Gate Road and River Ridge Drive beginning Monday, May 20, 2013. The City Council has awarded the project contract to James McHugh Construction Co. out of Chicago, Illinois. This is the same lead contractor that has been involved with the construction of the Red Gate Bridge project.

The scope of the work for this project includes the relocation of private utility infrastructure were necessary, installation of a new traffic signal including pedestrian countdown signals, removal and replacement of curb and sidewalk, installation of a new eastbound extended right-turn lane for the St. Charles North High School, and pavement resurfacing and restriping within the project limits.

All construction activities will take place within normal construction business hours; no Saturday work is expected at this time. As work progresses access through River Ridge drive at Red Gate Road may be delayed during the daytime working hours. Steps will be taken to reduce these kinds of interruptions.
