DISORDERLY CONDUCT⁵

9.20.010 Disorderly conduct - Designated - Prohibited.

It is unlawful for a person to commit disorderly conduct. A person commits disorderly conduct when he knowingly:

- A. Does any act in such unreasonable manner as to alarm or disturb another and to provoke a breach of the peace; or
- B. With intent to annoy another, makes a telephone call, whether or not conversation thereby ensues; or
- C. Enters upon the property of another for a lewd or unlawful purpose; deliberately looks into a dwelling on the property through any window or other opening.

9.20.020 Intoxication in public place prohibited.

It is unlawful for any person to be in an intoxicated condition on or in any street, alley or other public place in the City. Any person violating this Section shall be punished by a fine of not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) for each offense.

9.20.030 Disturbing lawful assemblages prohibited.

It is unlawful for any person to disturb any lawful assemblage or gathering in this city.

9.20.040 Unlawful assemblages.

It is unlawful to collect, gather, or be a member of any disorderly crowd, or any crowd gathering together for any unlawful purpose.
