Overview - *Position Description is available on the City website.*

The duties of the Certified Water Operator include installing, repairing and replacing water parts and equipment used in the water supply, pumping, storage and distribution systems. The Certified Water Operator will perform these duties using a variety of equipment and tools, such as a backhoe, end loader, bobcat, Hydrastop tapping machine, etc. In addition, the Certified Water Operator collects samples and performs tests for water quality analysis; maintains, repairs and builds the water distribution system; operates, inspects and repairs the pumping and storage systems; and operates, inspects, maintains and repairs the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system. This position may work scheduled overtime and will respond to emergency situations and will also support other city departments/divisions in the abatement of emergency situations.

Requirements

Applicants should possess general knowledge of water supply, pumping, storage and distribution systems and associated maintenance and repair methods, procedures, and techniques and the operation and maintenance of all pertinent machinery, equipment, and tools. Applicants must be able to work under varying environmental conditions, including confined spaces and lift up to 80 pounds. Must be able and willing to respond to emergency calls twenty-four (24) hours a day, seven (7) days a week, carry a wireless communications device, and possess a valid CDL with appropriate endorsements. Effective interpersonal and communication skills for interaction with elected and appointed officials, co-workers, agencies, other governmental units, and the public are required.

This position requires a high school diploma or equivalent, minimum five (5) years of experience in public works and/or construction industry, and possession of an Illinois class B Water Supply Operator license within 18 months of hire.

If selected, successful completion of a background check, physical, functional capacity evaluation, and drug screen are required. This position is covered by the Teamster bargaining unit and residency requirements must be met within 1 year. (See attached)

Salary range is \$25.68 – \$34.24/hr. Starting pay will be commensurate with experience. Excellent benefit package provided.
