The Fine Arts Show will be held on South Riverside Avenue between Main Street and Illinois, as well as Walnut between Riverside Avenue and 2nd Avenue from Friday, May 25th through Sunday, May 27th. The Downtown St. Charles Partnership is requesting the closure of the following streets:

- South Riverside Avenue from Main Street to Illinois Avenue from 5 a.m. on May 25th through 8 p.m. on Sunday, May 27th.
- Walnut Avenue from 2nd Avenue to Riverside Avenue from 5 p.m. on Friday, May 25th through 8 p.m. on Sunday, May 27th.
- The parking lot between Riverside and 2nd Avenues from 5 a.m. on Friday, May 25th through 8 p.m. on Sunday, May 27th.
- Use of the paved area on 1st Street south of Main Street between 1st Street and the river for the same time frame.

The event sponsor will remove all barricades from the street once all of the booths are gone.




