**Executive Summary:**

On April 19, 2012 at 10:00 AM, sealed bids for the 2012 MFT Street Rehabilitation Program were publicly opened and read aloud. The results of the bid opening are as follows:

Funding for this program is based on a combination of Motor Fuel Tax dollars (MFT), corporate and wastewater funds. The scope of work will include roadway, sidewalk, curb and inlet replacement, and selected storm and sanitary sewer replacement.
