
WHEREAS, MITCHELL WILCOX earned 33 merit badges, received numerous awards and recognitions, such as, Arrow of Light 2008, Order of the Arrow in 2011, First Year Arrowman Award 2012, World Conservation Award, and was on Wredling's Honor Roll to list a few; and

WHEREAS, MITCHELL WILCOX held several leadership positions: Senior Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Patrol Leader and Buglar. Mitchell has also attended many campouts and a high adventure trip; and

WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout service project, Mitchell, with the help of his fellow scouts, family, friends, community and local businesses, was able to clear a quarter mile trail and build a 20 foot bridge in Delnor Wood's Park, for the St Charles Park District. The 20 foot long bridge is 6 feet wide and connects the trail over a creek in the woods. The Park District will use the new trail to expand their Forestry program, which serves all the 4th grade elementary students in District 303. Mitchell also built a bench, which was placed along side the trail and next to the pond for the community to enjoy the natural areas. Mitchell planned, developed, and led this project, spending over 258 hours to accomplish it.
