I was recently informed by my 5<sup>th</sup> Ward alderman, Ed Bessner, that a vacancy may soon be open. I have a keen interest in history and the preservation of items of historical significance. I am also excited by the opportunity to get involved with my community at this level.

As background, my wife and I have resided in St. Charles since 2004. I was born in Maywood, Illinois, grew up in Bellwood, and lived for many years in Bloomingdale.
