Thank you for the opportunity to re-submit a request for funding from the Youth Commission of St. Charles. CASA Kane County has been providing a trained Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) who is also a Guardian ad Litem (GAL) volunteer to about 25 children annually from St. Charles for the past 27 years.


CASA Kane County has a need for resources for the children served from the St. Charles area. When a child enters foster care, their caregivers receive a monthly stipend to help cover the child's expenses—such as food, healthcare, minimal clothing, etc. Anything over and above this is often a hardship for foster families. The children in foster care who are living in St. Charles do not have additional funding for things that they need like extra clothes or coats, household items or other special needs they require. These are the types of things that our CASA/GAL volunteers will come to us and ask if we help fund these special requests and needs.

Our staff are always working to collect gift cards from places like Target and Walmart to help provide some of these needed items so they are available as the needs arise. After analyzing our list of children from the St. Charles area, it was determined that most could benefit from a gift card from one of those places to purchase clothes or household items. One specifically was interested in taking some classes and had the need for a computer.

CASA Kane County respectfully requests \$2,500 to purchase gift cards from Target and Walmart to help provide our youth with some necessities and extra special items that would increase their quality of life. These gift cards will be given to the CASA/GAL volunteers who have children from St. Charles who have the greatest needs.
