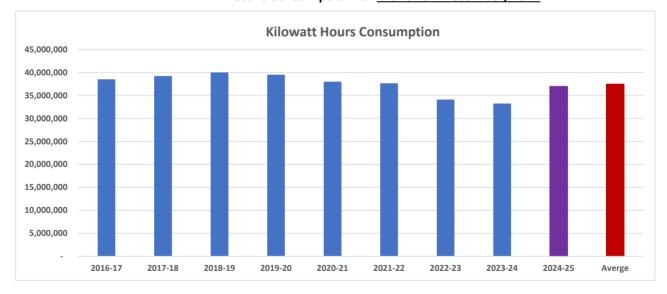

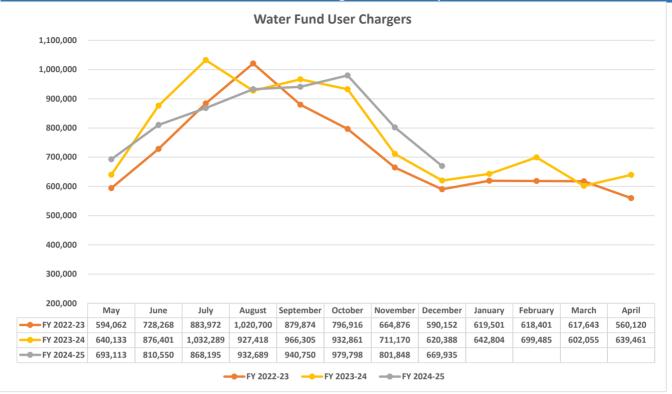

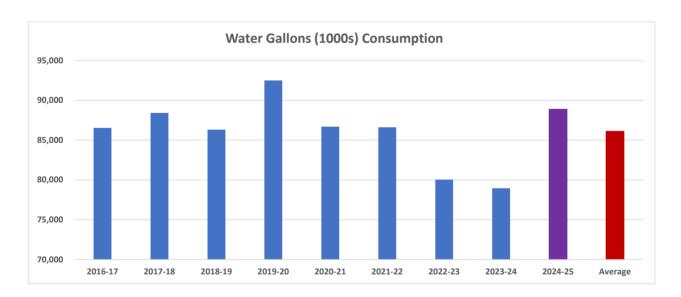
Electric Consumption for Month of: December, 2024



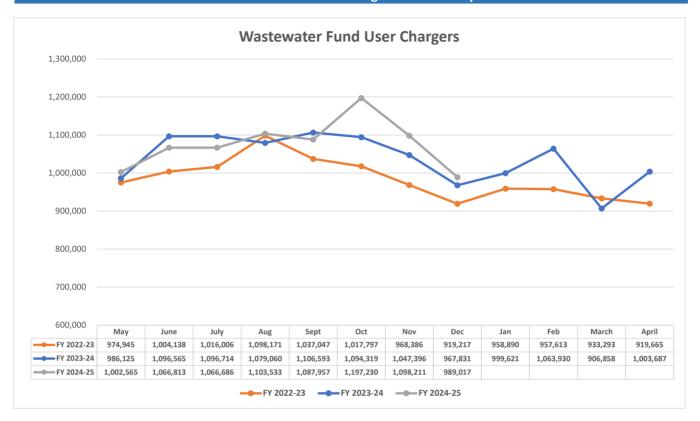

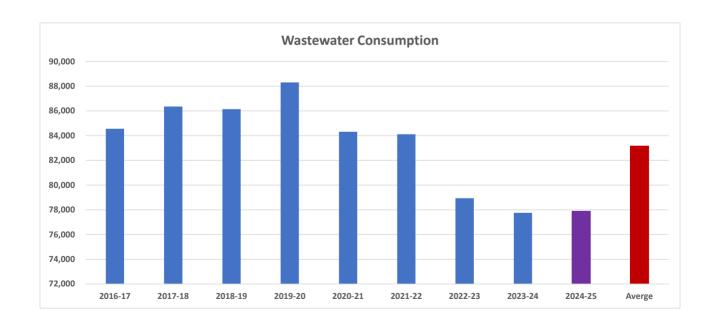
Water Consumption for Month of: December, 2024

Wastewater Consumption for Month of: December, 2024



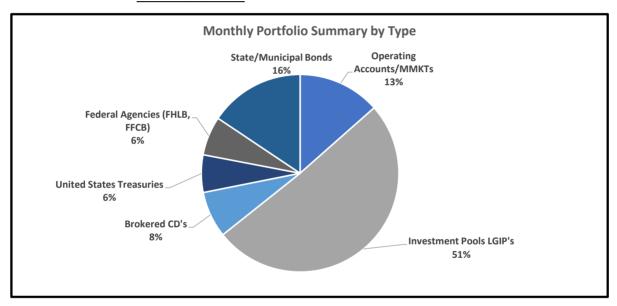

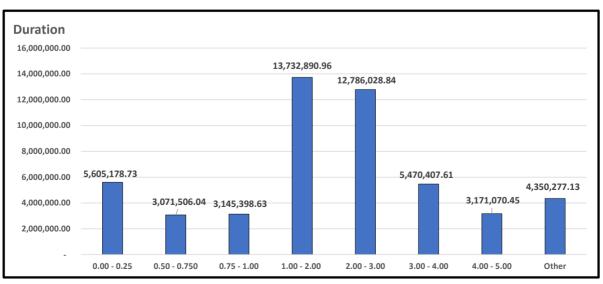

The cash settlement amount is approximately \$5.54 billion.
