NOW COMES the Petitioner, Dan Likens, Chief of Police of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, and files this complaint before the Local Liquor Control Commission of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, and states as follows:

1. The Petitioner is the duly appointed Chief of Police of the City of St. Charles and as such is charged with the duty of enforcing the laws of the State of Illinois and the Municipal Code of the City of St. Charles.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

2. On or about January 13, 2026, Whole Foods Market Group LLC d/b/a Whole Foods Market ("Licensee") was operating under a Liquor License issued by the City of St. Charles for the location at 300 S. 2nd Street, St. Charles, Illinois 60174 ("Premises").

3. On or about January 13, 2026, at approximately 5:59 p.m., Licensee, by and through its employees, officers and/or agents on the Premises, committed the following violation of the Municipal Code of the City of St. Charles, Title 5, Chapter 5.08.250(S)(1) and 235 ILCS 5/6-16(a)(i) of the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934:

OFFENSE

Sold alcoholic liquor to a person under the age of twenty-one (21) years, in violation of the Municipal Code of the City of St. Charles, Title 5, Chapter 5.08.250(S)(1) and 235 ILCS 5/6-16(a)(i) of the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934.

4. That the act detailed in this Complaint of Violation is prohibited and is in violation of and contrary to Section 5.08.250(S)(1) of the Municipal Code of the City of St. Charles and 235 ILCS 5/6-16(a)(i) of the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934.
