Multi-agency public safety training set for Dec. 12 at former Charlestowne Mall site in St. Charles
Simulated emergency activity expected with no impact on surrounding business operations

ST. CHARLES, Ill. (Dec. 12, 2025) – Today, multiple public safety agencies from around the area are participating in a planned group training exercise from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the former Charlestowne Mall site, 3700 E. Main St., in St. Charles.

Training exercises will be limited to the north and east sides of the mall and will not affect normal operations at nearby businesses. The public is asked to avoid the immediate training area.

During the two-hour training simulation, there may be increased emergency activity, including the presence of loud noises, simulated injuries, drones and an increased presence of emergency vehicles and a medical helicopter.

Officials emphasize that this is only an exercise, and there is no danger to the public.
