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St. Charles Police Department to Host Oct. 14, 2024, Open House, Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for New Public Safety Training Center to serve 35 Police Departments across Chicago Area

The facility includes a virtual training simulator, space for physical training, and a classroom. It is adjacent to the existing outdoor practice range on the site.

- The new facility will be used by St. Charles police, as well as 35 other police departments throughout the Chicago area.
- Funding for the entire project was secured through \$1.2 million in state grants and private donations.
