


# City of St. Charles Monthly Financial Report / Summary Electric User Charges and Consumption




### Electric Consumption for Month of: August, 2023






Water Consumption for Month of: August, 2023


### Wastewater Consumption for Month of: August, 2023



Executive Summary (if not budgeted, please explain):

The Government Operations Committee unanimously recommended approval of this item at the meeting on Sept. 18.

As stated at the Committee meeting, Staff reviewed options for alternate construction methods to reduce the cost to complete the street work. The attached revised proposal includes repair of curb cracks that are not showing signs of structural issues. The amount of curb replacement has been reduced, which also reduces the number of driveways that may be impacted by the curb work.

The revised proposal reduces the total cost from \$385k to \$363k. The anticipated shortfall from the Letter of Credit funds is reduced from \$42k down to around \$20k. The final number will be based on actual quantities. This will not be known until the work is completed.

Approval of the contract with Geneva Construction is contingent upon the City successfully obtaining the Letter of Credit funds. Once these funds are obtained, the contract will be signed.

Once the contract is signed, Geneva Construction will the schedule the work. Because we are near the end of the season, the ability for the contractor to schedule and complete the work this year is weather-dependent. But the contractor has indicated they will attempt to fit the project in this year.
