The sealed bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the office of the Procurement Division Manager located at 2 East Main Street, St. Charles, IL 60174, on the same date.

Scope of Project:

Rehabilitation work shall include, but not limited to, manhole lining; manhole cleaning and televising; root removal; manhole frame and cover modifications; bench/channel modifications; internal and external chimney seals; groundwater and surface water control; bypass pumping; traffic control; chemical grouting; joint repairs; manhole drop modifications; site restoration and appurtenances.
