The City of St. Charles Engineering Division of Public Works is pleased to inform you that the construction project in your neighborhood has been approved to proceed.

CONTRACTOR AND INSPECTOR:

The contract for this work has been awarded to A Lamp Concrete Contractors of Schaumburg, IL as the general contractor. Ken Jay, Public Works Manager - Engineering, will be the Project Manager for the City of St. Charles. The City has hired Josh Schmitt from H.R. Green to be the on-site resident engineer to complete construction inspections for the work and to be your personal construction liaison. Josh will be the primary contact person regarding any construction activity. START DATES AND COMPLETION DATES:

Expect to see JULIE locates this week, with construction staging, tree removals and temporary roadway widening expected next week. Sanitary sewer installation will begin in early June, followed by water main replacement, storm sewer replacement, and finally roadway reconstruction. Work is anticipated to be completed in October.
