ARCHITECTURAL FEATURES: The front gable includes a single car garage and an arched-top window on the 2nd floor. A narrow roof overhang covers the asymmetrical entry and a square bay window. The roof pitch is very shallow (3:12).

ALTERATIONS: The entire house has been remodeled assuming that the date of construction on record is correct. None of the original design elements appear to have been saved. A new porch railing is supported by turned balusters.
