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
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
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
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
I. SURVEY PURPOSE

The architectural survey of the central district of St. Charles was conducted as a means of recording all of the structures and sites in the survey area with written and photographic documentation. The resulting compilation of materials and information organized in the volumes that comprise the survey record should be a valuable document for the City of St. Charles now and for future generations.

This survey can be a valuable tool for increasing public awareness and appreciation of the architectural heritage that exists in the City of St. Charles. The survey can also be used to determine possible local landmarks and historic districts. It can be used as an aid in City planning and zoning so that significant buildings and districts can be maintained and valuable architectural heritage can be preserved. The survey is also of value to individual property owners or organizations wishing to obtain architectural information about their property or area and as a starting point for any intensive research or documentation.

The defined survey content and methodology provides a framework for future documentation of significant areas of St. Charles which are also rich in architectural heritage.

This survey is an authoritative and objective source which can be used to develop preservation plans and priorities both for specific buildings and areas and for the entire community. The survey can be used effectively for preservation at all levels, to gain federal and state recognition for important local buildings and sites, to enhance local public awareness and gain local support for preservation to assist the St. Charles Historic Preservation Commission in reviewing changes proposed to designated local landmarks and to develop and implement preservation plans and supporting legislation.



II. SURVEY CONTENT AND METHODOLOGY

CONTENT

The Architectural Survey of the St. Charles Central District includes written and photographic documentation of every primary structure and site within the survey boundaries. Photographic documentation consists of black and white prints of the primary elevations and significant outbuildings and a color slide of the primary elevation. Photographic negatives for each print are referenced on the survey form by roll number and negative number and are catalogued and stored in Volume 5 of the Survey Record.

Written documentation of each primary structure is recorded on the survey forms and includes information about the integrity of the structure, architectural style, and or significant known changes or alterations that may have been made to the structure. The structure is also rated as to the present condition of the exterior.

METHODOLOGY

The Architectural Survey of the St. Charles Central District is a comprehensive survey which involved documentation of every primary structure and site in the survey area regardless of age or architectural value. Comprehensive surveys are recommended by the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency in the

publication How to Conduct a Local Survey of Architectural and/or Historical Resources (October 1987) which states that..

"A comprehensive local survey which examines every building and site both individually and in the context of its surroundings . . . involves buildings and areas that are of interest to every member of the community."

The publication further states that...

"Intelligent preservation planning is only possible when a comprehensive survey has examined all the structures in a community. The survey provides a solid basis for evaluating the architectural and historical significance of each structure individually and in the context of its surroundings. It becomes an essential part of all local planning efforts, including, on the one hand, general community development projects, transportation plans and downtown renewal, and, on the other hand, specific preservation plans, identification of buildings worthy of preservation and the creation of historic districts."

A comprehensive survey approach also increases the value of the survey as a historical record for future generations by reducing the influence of a possible bias toward current "popular" styles or physical condition of the structure. Buildings of recent construction are documented in an unaltered condition and may be of value to future restorations in the century to come. In addition, the context of the entire area can be evaluated and streetscapes examined rather than isolated structures. In summary, a comprehensive survey has many benefits beyond simply documenting known historically or architecturally important structures and provides valuable information for present and future generations.

The survey was conducted by a survey team of two field surveyors, Michael A. Dixon, AIA and David T. McNally, and two office staff members, Brian J. Kerner and Susan Franck, who were involved in the transfer of field notes onto the final survey form. A small survey team is recommended by the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency to minimize problems of coordination and supervision and maximize consistency of survey results.

The survey was undertaken in several phases which related to types of materials and resources to be collected, as well as parameters set by nature which influenced photographic work.

PHASE 1 - Photographic Field Work

The structures were photographed by the survey team on foot, walking the entire area and individually photographing each structure. Careful records were maintained to identify each photo with the correct structure. The weather conditions and time of day influenced when the photo of any particular structure could be taken to capture the proper sun angle and avoid excessive shadows.

PHASE 2 - Field Completion of Survey Forms


This phase represents the majority of time spent by the survey team in conducting the survey. This phase included the compilation of the survey information onto "field forms" that were later turned over to the office staff for entry into a computer database.

PHASE 3 - Printing, photomounting and collating

The final documentation of this survey includes the printing of each survey form utilizing computer files, mounting photographic prints to each form and organizing the forms into a useable format. The forms are organized by block number and are referenced on a map showing the Survey Area (See IV. Survey Area).

PHASE 4 - Survey Summary

After all the survey forms were completed, the results were tabulated and listed in several formats to allow understandable overviews of the survey area, including architectural styles found in the survey area and the number of significant and contributing structures.



III. DEFINITIONS AND CRITERIA

Conducting a survey with clear definitions of important terms and set criteria for rating structures is important for the consistency and clarity of the survey results. The following definitions and criteria were used by the survey team for evaluating each structure or site in this survey.

**ARCHITECTURAL
INTEGRITY:**

Evaluation of any changes or additions made to the exterior of the building. Check-off boxes include the following:

Unaltered:

Based on field observation, no major alterations or additions to the original exterior are apparent.

**Minor
Alteration:**

Based on field observation, some minor alterations to the original exterior are apparent. Such minor alterations do not substantially change the significant exterior materials or details and do not impose on the structure's original character.

Major Alteration:

Based on field observation, major alterations to the original exterior are apparent. Such major alterations do alter the original character of the structure by changing or removing the significant exterior materials, details, windows or doors.

Additions:

Additions to a structure can range from surface additions such as signage, flagpoles, awnings and other easily removable features to structural additions such as building additions, porches and other not easily removable features.

Additions are further evaluated as being one of the following:

Sensitive: Additions that retain or blend with the original character of the building through use of appropriate scale, details, materials and color.

Insensitive: Additions that do not blend with the original character of the building and are of inappropriate scale, details, materials or color.

AREAS OF EXTERIOR ANALYSIS:

The architectural integrity is evaluated for the following three main areas of the structure. The terms storefront, upper floors and cornice apply to commercial buildings and the terms first floor, upper floors and roof refer to residential and other structures.

**Storefront:
(first floor)** Area from the ground line up the second floor line usually defined at the top by a signage band, beltcourse or change of materials.

Upper Floors: Area from the top of the storefront or first floor to the roofline.

**Cornice:
(roof)** Area at the top of the building which may be a decorative band, parapet or roof eave.

ARCHITECTURAL STYLE: This survey is based on Architectural Style as identified and described in the reference materials listed in the bibliography. A summary of the styles found in this survey area is listed below. An additional category "Substantially Altered" has been added to this survey and applied to structures that have been altered to the extent that the original architectural style is no longer evident.

EXTERIOR CONDITION: Evaluation of the condition of exterior materials based on field observation. Check-off boxes include:

Excellent: Based on visual inspection, the structure appears to have no physical defects to exterior materials that could not be corrected by routine maintenance.

Good: Based on visual inspection, the structure appears to have some physical defects to exterior materials that require maintenance such as painting and minor repairs.

Fair: Based on visual inspection, the structure appears to have physical defects to the exterior materials that requires substantial repair and possibly some structural corrections.

Poor: Based on visual inspection, the structure appears to have physical defects to the exterior materials that will require substantial repair and/or structural corrections in order to improve its deteriorated condition.

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE:

Evaluation of the structure in terms of importance to the City of St. Charles. Check-off boxes include:

Significant: The structure or site, due to architectural merit should be considered to be of intrinsic value to the heritage of the City of St. Charles and efforts to further document and preserve the structure or site should be undertaken.

Contributing: The structure should be considered to be an integral part of a possible historic district. The structure may be considered contributing due to architectural merit or because of its potential as a contributing structure if missing elements were reconstructed or inappropriate elements removed.

Non-Contributing: The structure should not be considered to be an integral part of a possible historic district due to lack of architectural merit because inappropriate additions or exterior alterations have substantially changed the character of the structure, or because the structure detracts from the physical character of the area.


**REPRESENTATION IN
EXISTING SURVEYS:**

Federal: The structure has been identified and documented for inclusion on the National Register of Historic Places.

State: The structure has been identified and documented as part of the Illinois Historic Structures Survey conducted in 1972 or as part of the Illinois Historic Landmarks Survey conducted in 1974. Copies of the survey cards compiled by the state are available at the Illinois Historic Preservation Agency in Springfield, Illinois.

County: The structure has been identified and documented as part of the Kane County Urban Development Study.

Local: The structure has been previously identified by the St. Charles Historical Society or the Pottawatomie Garden Club as eligible for award of a plaque as a historic structure.



IV. SURVEY AREA

The St. Charles Central District survey area includes all structures west of the Fox River to Fifth Street, bounded by State Street to the north and Indiana Street to the south; and east of the Fox River to Sixth Avenue, bounded by Park Avenue to the north and Indiana Avenue to the south.


The following map shows the survey area. A complete list of streets which all or sections fall in the survey area is listed below.




V. SURVEY SUMMARY


The Architectural Survey of the St. Charles Central District is comprised of photographic and written documentation of individual structures and recorded on survey forms for each structure or site. Useful information has been compiled from these individual forms in order to gain information about the survey area as a whole.

Several types of ratings and architectural information are included on the forms and are defined in Section III: "Definitions and Criteria". These ratings and categories include information about architectural significance and architectural style. Various tabulations of this information are included in this section for evaluation purposes. It should be noted, however, that the area of the survey is expansive and includes a wide variety of "sub-areas" that were developed at different times. Subsequently, the following summaries should not be viewed as an evaluation of the survey area as a whole as to its significance, but rather as general tabulations of different types of information concerning structures within the survey area.



V. SURVEY SUMMARY

The Architectural Survey of the St. Charles Central District is comprised of photographic and written documentation of individual structures and recorded on survey forms for each structure or site. Useful information has been compiled from these individual forms in order to gain information about the survey area as a whole.

Several types of ratings and architectural information are included on the forms and are defined in Section III: "Definitions and Criteria". These ratings and categories include information about architectural significance and architectural style. Various tabulations of this information are included in this section for evaluation purposes. It should be noted, however, that the area of the survey is expansive and includes a wide variety of "sub-areas" that were developed at different times. Subsequently, the following summaries should not be viewed as an evaluation of the survey area as a whole as to its significance, but rather as general tabulations of different types of information concerning structures within the survey area.
