City of St. Charles Downtown Parking Study Update

ST. CHARLES, III. (Jan. 15, 2024) – In June 2023, the City of St. Charles City Council approved a contract with Desman Inc. to conduct a Downtown Parking Study. The purpose of the study is to provide City Council and staff with insight and data on the current downtown parking environment and recommend initiatives that enhance the parking experience for all downtown visitors.

Desman Inc. has concluded the draft of the downtown parking study, which is now available for the public to review on the City's website. To engage the community further, interested parties are encouraged to participate by providing feedback through a brief online survey or an upcoming open house meeting on January 23 from 4:30 – 6:00pm in the St. Charles City Hall Council Chambers. Mayor Vitek emphasized the significance of public input, noting, "We value the input of our community members.
