



Construction Notification IL Route 31 and Roosevelt St. Sewer Main Replacement

June 30, 2021

Dear Residents,

Work associated with the new water main and sanitary sewer utilities to be constructed on Roosevelt Street between Geneva Road (Route 31) and Elm Street will begin next week. More specifically, the Contractor will be milling off portions of the pavement in anticipation of the utilities being installed. **Milling operations will occur on Tuesday July 6th and are anticipated to last only one day.**

During milling operations, Roosevelt Street will remain open to traffic but reduced to one lane where work is actively being performed. Flaggers will be present to control and direct traffic as needed.

No on-street parking will be allowed on Roosevelt Street on Tuesday July 6th between the hours of 6:30 AM and 5 PM. During this time, you may park on adjacent side streets. Driveway access will be maintained during milling operations; however, minor delays of getting in and out of your driveway may occur.

Due to the Fourth of July holiday, garbage pick-up for Tuesday July 6th will shift to Wednesday July 7th.

As the project progresses, additional door notices will be distributed keeping you informed of such things as temporary road closures, water loss, driveway restrictions, etc. Current notifications will also be posted on the City's website at <https://www.stcharlesil.gov/projects/rte-31-roosevelt-st-trunk-sewer-main-replacement-project> The project is scheduled to be completed by November 19, 2021. As with all construction projects of this nature, schedules are weather dependent. We will do our best to notify you of any schedule changes due to inclement weather.
