## City of St. Charles Utility Billing Office Closed for In-Person Visits Feb. 16, 2024

**ST. CHARLES**, Ill. (Feb. 15, 2024) – The City of St. Charles launched its new utility billing software Feb. 13, 2024. To help complete the first round of billings with the new system, the Utility Billing office will be closed to in-person visits only Friday, February 16. Phone calls are welcome.

Payments also can be deposited in one of four drop boxes conveniently located throughout town:

- 1. East side 2700 block of East Main St., in the Foxfield Commons Shopping Center
- 2. Downtown Municipal Building, 2 E. Main St., at the southeast side of the building
- 3. Downtown Municipal Building north parking lot, next to the USPS mailbox
- 4. West side St. Charles Police Station, 1515 W. Main Street
