Subject: Patricia Lane Road Closure - Upcoming Construction Schedule

Dear Resident:

We are scheduled to complete roadway improvements to Patricia Lane next week. The contractor will be removing the asphalt pavement, performing base reclamation with cement and then paving the new roadway. The street will be closed to all traffic between Division Street and Via Veneto Drive on **Monday, June 10th at 7:00 AM CDT**, and it will remain closed until late afternoon hours of Thursday, June 13th.

Parking Requirements: All vehicles must be relocated from driveways and off of Patricia Lane by no later than 7:00 AM Monday, June 10, 2019. Please continue to use alternate parking locations on Division Street and Via Veneto Drive.

Detailed construction schedule:

- **Monday June 10th: 7:00 AM**, Patricia Lane to be closed from Division Street to Via Veneto Drive. Garbage pickup will occur as regularly scheduled, please have your garbage at the curb by 6:30 AM, as the refuse company will be making Patricia Lane their first pickup of the day. Asphalt pavement removal to be completed. Once the pavement has been removed, there will be a 5" drop off at the curb at the end of your driveway.
- **Tuesday, June 11th: Road closure will remain.** Base Reclamation with Cement to be performed.
- **Wednesday, June 12th: Road closure will remain.** New roadway base will be primed and continue to cure (strengthen.)
- **Thursday, June 13th: Road closure will remain.** New asphalt roadway surface to be paved. Roadway to be opened to traffic by end of work day.

Please note that this process is weather dependent. If there are any major changes in the weather forecast, the City will be providing an updated schedule.

Mail Delivery Update:

We have been in communication with the postal service regarding the upcoming roadway closure. The postal carrier may hold mail during the road closure. Please contact the local post office if you are expecting an urgent delivery.


