<u>Technology Initiative Update</u>

Larry Gunderson reminded the Committee that the technology initiatives in support of the Strategic Plan are to Modernize the City's digital presence and evaluate risks to the organization. Work has begun on the new City website project. The new City Codebook is expected to be up and running within a few months. Increasing digital forms is another initiative to be undertaken. A new portal for the utility billing system will be active by the end of August. A new managed security services provider is assisting the City to evaluate risks to the organization and the team is already seeing great results.

Overview of Geographic Information Systems (GIS)

Eric Creighton spoke to the Committee about the location services, which ties everything to a specific location and has data attached. This supports efficient information gathering and decision making. Some examples are the Zoning Map, the Lead Survey Dashboard, and My Neighborhood application. City staff, especially the Public Works Department, uses GIS information extensively. More information will be provided in the future regarding the application for the utility network.
