## **District 303 Implementing INCubatoredu for the 2018-2019 School Year**

Community Unit School District 303 is implementing of a program called INCubatoredu, which will offer a unique and authentic entrepreneurship experience for students at St. Charles East and St. Charles North High Schools. Throughout the program, students will work collaboratively to brainstorm ideas, and develop a product or service in an attempt to gain funding in a final “Shark Tank” like pitch event.

Community participation is a crucial piece of the program. District 303 will be asking local entrepreneurs and business experts to serve as volunteer coaches and mentors to guide student teams through the process. Students and their mentors will work to develop hypotheses about a business concept, test those hypotheses, make adaptations, and continually learn and improve. The cycle of learning and experimentation is combined with foundational business content such as marketing and finance. The businesses students build are real, not simulated, and students are encouraged to take risks and experience mistakes. The INCubatoredu program is aligned with the National Consortium of Entrepreneurship standards, the Common Core State Standards for Speaking and Listening, and the 21st Century Learning and Innovation Skills standards.

Students who earn funding as a result of the pitch event may continue to year two of the program, ACCEratoredu. The focus during the second year is on evolving the product or service, customer acquisition, and building operations to support the business.

The successful implementation relies heavily on community support and there are multiple opportunities for community members to get involved. Below is an outline of the multiple volunteer opportunities with brief explanations of those roles.
