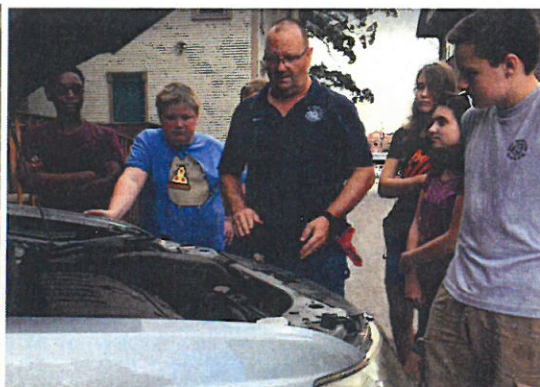
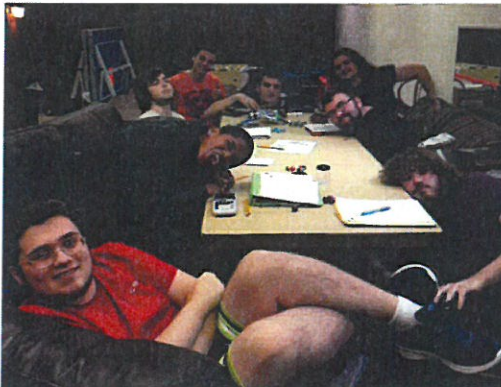

- St. Charles Park District **requested \$10,000 to use towards renovating the study center** area within the community's downtown teen center. The Park District also budgeted \$5,000 and received \$5,000 from the Kane County Health Department to use towards the project.
- The teen center is a **place where all students within the D303 boundaries are welcome**. Most visitors are not interested in afterschool sports or clubs, so the teen center allows them to build social networks and enjoy educational and recreational pursuits in an alternate, safe setting.
- Teen center **staff work with the schools, promoting programs, positive recreational behaviors, citizenship and drug and alcohol prevention**.
- **Renovations will enhance the usability, accessibility and appeal of the study center space**.
