Dear Youth Commission,

The STC Underground enters its fifteenth year of operation expecting to see over 800 different teens accounting for a projected 5,000 visits in 2016. This one-of-a-kind facility offers a safe space for St. Charles' teens to gather, learn new skills and enjoy their favorite hobbies. The Park District has committed to providing the Underground as an opportunity for all, despite economic, social or other barriers. It is with financial assistance from community partners like the St. Charles Youth Commission that we may continue this service.

Last May, we received your generous donation of \$3,500. This funding assisted with over forty special programs, including: Music Making, Geocaching, Flag Football, Chili Making, Anti-Valentines Party, and more. We estimate that 1/5 of our 5,000 annual visits occur during special programming.

This year, we request a similar commitment of \$3,500 to assist with costs of special programs. Our 2016 budget for the Underground, including \$3,500 from Youth Commission, shows revenues of \$10,200 and expenses totaling \$121,500. As you can imagine, every bit helps.

As always, thank you for your consideration for financial assistance as we continue to develop and offer recreational and personal development opportunities for St. Charles teens.
