Average # of "standards": 7*

 \$ per year that is unused: \$2562 = 17% (\$12,810 over 5 years)

SAMPLE Youth Commission Campaign

Campaign: "Take a Breather"

Campaign Mission Statement: Based on student surveys provided through D303, interviews with local mental health providers, meetings with D303 administration, statistical reports from the Kane County ROE, and informal discussions with D303 high school students, students are feeling "overly stressed" which is resulting in higher levels of self-injurious behavior and/or increased number of psychiatric hospitalizations as well as general feelings of anxiety and depression among St. Charles youth. The "Take a Breather Campaign" is a community-wide effort for our youth to develop the various life-long skills they need for effective emotional and physical well-being by learning how to manage their stress and un-plug from daily pressures.

Collaboration with Community Partners: *(Ideas that are brought to us by our community partners)*

St. Charles Park District-

Through the STC Underground the park district will bring in mindfulness training, yoga opportunities, and presentation on mindfulness/visual imagery apps. \$3600

St. Charles School District-

Through the Parent University d303 will organize a presenter regarding teaching children resiliency and helping parents develop strategies in an achievement-oriented culture. \$1000

Tri-City Family Services -

Promote use of mindfulness/yoga/stress management in individual sessions and create a "Stress-less" work shop for STC grade school students. \$1000

St. Charles Library-

Create a Self-Care Book and Resource Display in the "Loft"
Add a "relaxation room" to Exam Cram \$750

St. Charles Police Department -

Distribute "Take a Breather Stickers" to young kids engaged in health activities outside in the community. \$100
