INVESTMENT ACTIVITIES

<u>Discuss Investment Allocations of Property Tax Receipts</u> –Jon Willhite reviewed the proposed rebalancing and status of the investment markets as well as the Fund's portfolio. The rebalancing is necessary due to the recent receipt of property tax revenues and the anticipated of the second large disbursement of property tax revenues in September or October. Willhite proposed moving \$819,000 from the cash account into fixed income (\$490,000 in total-\$245,000 each to Pacific Advisors) and equities (\$135,000 to Riverfront Asset Allocations and \$194,000 to American Beacon) to better meet cash flow needs until the next large disbursement while also meeting Investment Policy guidelines and statutory requirements.

Willhite also noted that that rising interest rates seem to be providing additional volatility to the markets right now but the Fund's portfolio should be well positioned with our managers and mix. Some of the recent moves made have provided hedges against downside volatility in past markets and we anticipate that they will provide protection in the current market environment as well.

At the time of his employment termination, the contract for the patrol officers was still pending approval. Oko is due a refund on retro pay withholdings of \$165.67.

If approved, President Boyce would direct Attorney LaBardi to contact Kern and make the arrangements for Kern to be tested to verify that he continues to qualify as disabled per statue. This test will be performed in Illinois.
