Two delivery methods, pneumatic or dump, are utilized due to site restrictions; therefore, a unit price cost was requested for each. Salt usage is based on water production; therefore, there might be a slight variation in salt usage from year to year. Currently, the city uses an average of 900 tons of water treatment salt per year, with approximately 400 tons in pneumatic deliveries and 500 tons in dump deliveries.
