This special event application was submitted on May 23, 2017 and the committee met with the event organizer on May 30th.

This event was launched last year as a celebration for the Arcada's 90th birthday. Event organizers are requesting this be an annual event and have requested the route begin at 1st Street, with all parade participants lining up on 1st St and continuing east on Illinois Ave, if necessary, for line-up purposes. They have requested the route be extended one block this year and turn off at 3rd Ave from Main St. The parade will then turn onto Walnut Ave from 3rd Ave and end at Riverside & Walnut Avenues. This year's event is set to take place on Monday, September 4, 2017 (Labor Day). The following road and parking lot closures have been requested:

Riverside Ave from Main St to Illinois Ave from 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.

Walnut Ave from 3rd Ave to Riverside Ave from 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.

City Parking Lot "B" – Second Court Lot (located at 2nd Avenue and Walnut Avenue) from 10 a.m. – 8 p.m.

A car show prior to the parade and a free show at the theatre at the end of the parade are also part of this event.

Fees for City services will be paid in full by the event organizers.
