Executive Summary (if not budgeted please explain):					
Events Committee to discuss the parameters of the events on February 8 th . Along with the annual color, 5K, and 10K runs, the River Corridor Foundation and the St. Charles Kiwanis will be hosting their first Tug Event. This event will take place on Sunday, May 20, 2018, following the morning runs.					
The Tug Event consists of a traditional rope pulling contest ("tug-of-war") with 2 teams competing to pull the other team approximately 20 feet, while the rope is stretched across the Fox River. This mirrors several tug events that have been held worldwide, in places like Okinawa, Japan; Port Byron, IL; and LeClaire, IA; and will be held in accord with the International Tug of War Federation rules.					
The Tug of War will begin at approximately 11:00 am and last until 4:00 pm, depending on the number of teams participating. The layout of the Tug Event will require use of the BMO Harris Parking lot, First St. Construction area, and the First Street Plaza. This event will require the closing of Riverside Ave. (between Main St. and Walnut Ave.) and S. 1 st St. (between Main St. and the north entrance of the 1 st Street Parking Garage).









Bob Leonard 10k 10 km Saint Charles, Illinois
