Executive Summary *(if not budgeted please explain):*

The Camp Kane event had already been approved by City Council to take place June 11-12, 2016; however, due to the low amount of registrations, it was cancelled. The group wishes to reschedule this event to take place in Langum Park on Saturday, September 24 and 25, 2016. The only other event taking place that weekend is the Walk to End Alzheimer's, which will take place Sunday the 25th. These events will not interfere with each other due to the fact they will be taking place in different locations in the City.

This revised application was received on August 5, 2016 and the special events committee met to discuss the event on August 18, 2016.

This event is being organized by the Camp Kane Heritage Foundation and 8th Illinois Calvary as an educational fund-raiser and family event. For a fee of \$10 per tent, families will be able to tent camp among the tents of an 8th Illinois Calvary encampment. A central campfire location will be set with minimal, if any, cooking being done. City services requested for this event include use of the water spigot in the park and porta-john set-up (\$60 fee posted above).

Set up will take place on Saturday around 1 p.m.; visitors will be invited to enter beginning at 3:00 p.m. Take down on Sunday will take place between 2 and 3 p.m.

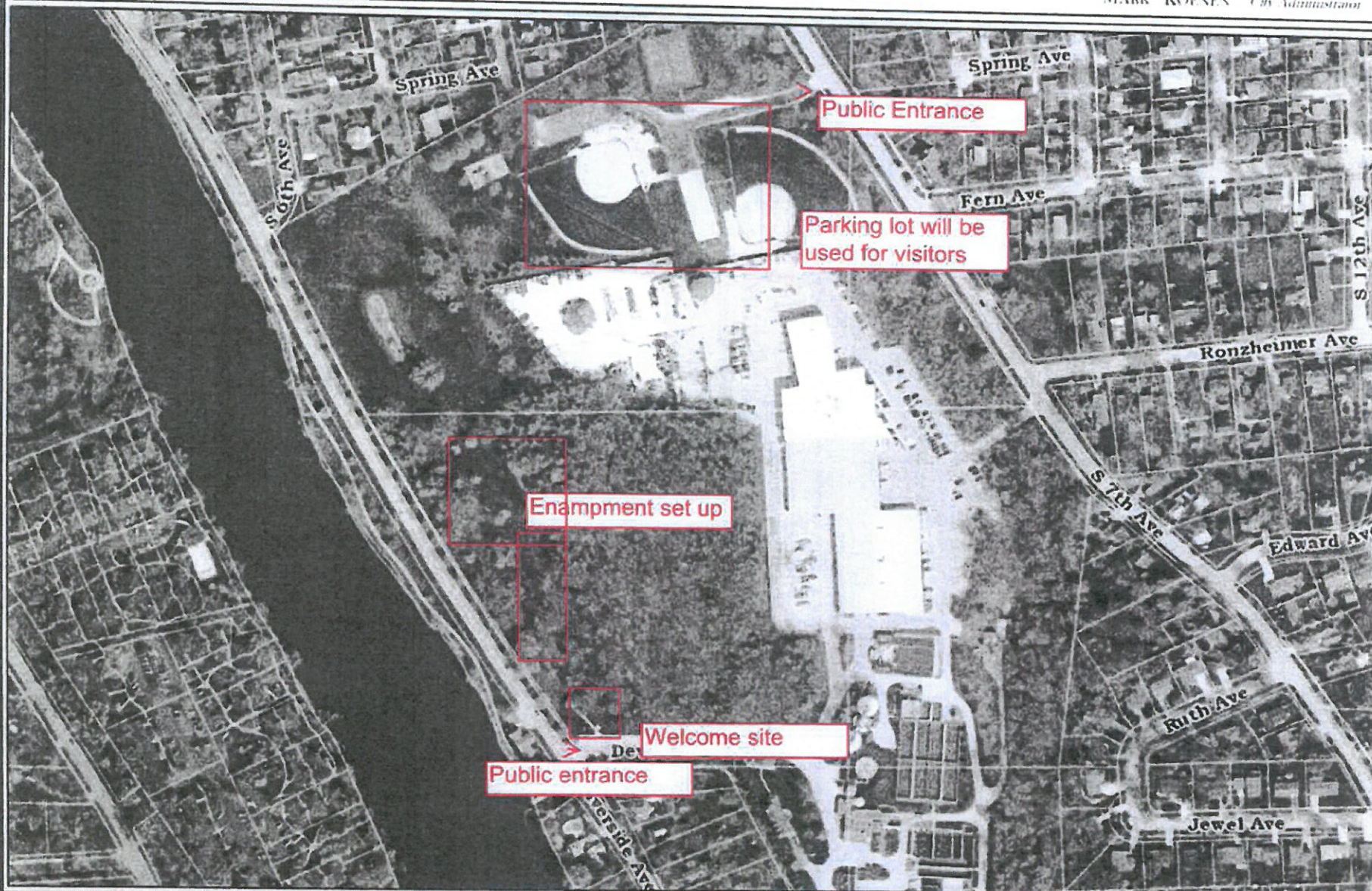
No alcohol will be permitted at this event.
