Executive Summary *(if not budgeted please explain):*

As part of the CMOM program and general maintenance of the sanitary sewer system, the City conducts a main line sewer root removal program. This work is completed by a contractor using an environmentally safe and IEPA approved root control chemical. The chemical is directly applied to the roots within the sewer system with the general intent to stop root growth. This is in an effort to reduce the risk of main line sewer backup caused by roots. The treatment areas are identified by the CMOM program and City sewer cleaning crews. In general, the City treats about 20,000 linear feet of sanitary sewers annually, with the program continually growing as the sewer system ages.

On August 26, 2020 the City received one (1) bid submittal for the Root Control Program. The sole bidder was Duke's Root Control Inc. City staff has evaluated and approved their submittal. Duke's Root Control has completed the same work for the City over the last five years, and has not had any performance issues with Dukes. The proposed unit cost is slightly higher than last year, but the proposed unit cost is valid for a three-year period with no annual increase.

Based on Duke's past performance and the submitted bid proposal, Staff recommends to award the unit cost contract to Duke's Root Control Inc. The option of two additional years will be exercised at the sole discretion of the City and approval of the fiscal budget and contractor performance.

e. The eProcurement software will automatically calculate all line item pricing into extended and total price.

f. QUANTITIES FOR FISCAL YEARS 21-22 AND 22-23 will be provided when said fiscal budget is approved.

2. **All prices quoted include all fees.** The city will not accept additional costs or surcharges such as, but not limited to: shipping, handling, freight, stocking, delivery, fuel sur-charge, travel, permits, or other.

3. **The Illinois Prevailing Wage Act** (820 ILCS 130/0.01-12) will be applicable for this work.
