# Parking Garage Options

The following recommendations come after the November 1, 2021, city council meeting and public comment about the parking garage. During the public comment a citizen brought up at least three different points to consider to include, adding security cameras, adding speed bumps to the fourth floor, and hiring private security to patrol the parking deck. These three points as well adding paid parking access systems to the entrances of the parking deck will be outlined as follows.

## Speed bumps on the fourth and fifth floors

Total cost of adding a speed bump to the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> floors is approximately \$15,000.00.

## Security Cameras

Cost of adding cameras to the remaining 4 floors of the deck \$51,190.00.

Upgrading current exterior and adding more exterior cameras to Main St. that would be able to view the plaza and Main St. in both directions \$15,625.00.

I would suggest do the above on the east side of the river as well \$15,625.00

Total cost approximately \$82,440.00.
