

**Executive Summary** (if not budgeted please explain):

Proposed Cost: \$ 330,000.00

The Electric Utility utilizes directional boring and excavation for emergency repairs, new development work and distribution underground improvements.

Budgeted Amount: \$ 330,000.00

Not Budgeted:

In spring 2017, this work was bid and awarded to Archon as the lowest responsive bidder out of seven (7). The bid was awarded for a three-year period based on the first year's pricing and a 5% increase in year two and another 5% increase in year three, both of which were conditional upon the Electric Utility's satisfaction and customer service to the City of St. Charles.

At the end of the third-year extension, Archon offered a fourth year extension at a small increase of 3% to cover contractual labor cost increases, which was presented to Government Services and approved by City Council. Archon has performed very well for the City consistently with very satisfactory results, even throughout the COVID environment, and they are offering the City another one year extension at another small 3% increase to cover labor costs for the period of May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022.
