Executive Summary (if not budgeted please explain):								
Over the past several months the contractor, IHC, Trotter and Associates Engineering, and City staff has worked closely together to minimize the delayed delivery of the Motor Control Panels (MCC) for the Phosphorus and Digester Improvement Project. The manufacturing of the MCC panels were delayed in Texas because of increased demands and factory damages that occurred as a result of 2017 hurricanes Harvey and Irma. As a result of the manufacturer's delays, the project was faced with a 90 day delay. The team has worked closely to review the scope of work and has made some modifications to the construction schedule to minimize the delay of the project. Due to the nature of the deferral, the contractor is also trying to minimize the impact by agreeing on a final time extension of 56 days.								
The changes to the construction process will not compromise the project or the services the City receives from the contractor. Instead, the contractor has agreed to proceed with the time extension at no cost and in a timely manner. In addition, Trotter and Associates has also agreed to extend their contract at no additional cost.								
The City recommends approving the extension to 56 days to IHC at no cost to the City. This joint effort has continued to ensure the City is receiving the most efficient and cost effective value during this construction project.
