Portions of the 2018 Street Rehabilitation Program will be paid for with Motor Fuel Tax (MFT) funds. The attached Resolution for Improvement Under the Illinois Highway Code is an agreement with the Illinois Department of Transportation. It specifies the streets to be constructed and details the amount of Motor Fuel Tax funds appropriated for this project for construction. The total appropriation includes the total cost of the project award for MFT, and only the final amount spent on the contract is what will be the final appropriation from the MFT fund.
