1.12.010 – Established

The corporate seal of the city shall be as follows: the seal heretofore provided and used by and for the city, the impression on which is a representation of a figure in the center with a white robe thrown across the left shoulder; in the left hand an evenly balanced scale, in the extended right hand a short sword, with the inscription "City of St. Charles, Illinois Incorporated October 17, 1874" around the outer edge of said seal; said seal is established to be the seal of the city.

**An Ordinance Amending Title 1 “General Provisions”, Section 1.12
“Corporate Seal” of the City of St. Charles Municipal Code**

WHEREAS, the City of St. Charles (“City) is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, affixing a symbol to seal a document is a standard custom used to legitimize or validate a document and its purpose; and

WHEREAS, an update to the existing seal is necessary and proper to St. Charles’ municipal operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That section 1.12.010, “Corporate Seal” of the St. Charles Municipal code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefore:

1.12.010 Established

The corporate seal of the city shall be as follows: the seal heretofore provided a used by and for the city, the impression on which is a representation of a figure in the center with a white robe thrown across the left shoulder; in the left hand an evenly balanced scale, in the extended right hand a short sword, with the inscription “City of St. Charles, Illinois Incorporated October 17, 1874” around the outer edge of said seal; said seal is established to be the seal of the city

That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation with the City of St. Charles.
