#### **COMPLAINT OF VIOLATION**

**NOW COMES** the Petitioner, James Keegan, Chief of Police of the City of St. Charles, Illinois and files this complaint before the Local Liquor Control Commission of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, and states as follows:

- 1. The Petitioner is the duly appointed Chief of Police of the City of St. Charles and as such is charged with the duty of enforcing the laws of the State of Illinois and the ordinances of the City of St. Charles.
- 2. In the month of, September, 2018; October, 2018; November, 2018; December, 2018; and January, 2019, the Licensee, Deepa Foods, Inc. d/b/a 7-Eleven, by and through its employees, officers and/or agents, committed the following violations of the St. Charles Liquor Code:

#### **OFFENSES**

#### (Count I)

Failed to pay alcohol tax for the tax period ending September 30, 2018, which was due and owing on October 31, 2018.

#### (Count II)

Failed to pay alcohol tax for the tax period ending October 31, 2018, which was due and owing on November 30, 2018.

#### (Count III)

Failed to pay alcohol tax for the tax period ending November 30, 2018, which was due and owing on December 31, 2018.

#### (Count IV)

Failed to pay alcohol tax for the period ending on December 30, 2018, which was due on January 31, 2019.

#### (Count V)

Failed to pay alcohol tax for the period ending on January 31, 2019, which was due on February 28, 2019.

- 3. At the time of the above violations, Deepa Foods, Inc. d/b/a 7-Eleven. was operating under a Class A6 liquor license issued by the City of St. Charles.
- 4. That the acts detailed in Section 1, 2 and 3 of this Complaint of Violation each are prohibited and are in violation of and contrary to Section 3.42.090 of the St. Charles Municipal Code (Alcohol Tax Ordinance) and the Liquor Control Act of 1934.
