EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Baker Memorial United Methodist Church is proposing to relocate the church's refuse enclosure from 217 Cedar Ave. to the northeast corner of the church building (corner of 4th and Cedar Ave.).

The enclosure will consist of a CMU wall covered with stone veneer to match the existing building stone and a cedar gate.

A drawing of the enclosure and proposed landscaping have been provided.


EX. CURB-


- 1. Strip topsoil from entire work area and stockpile just to the south. Remove existing Yew. At completion of the building work, remove construction debris and cut grade to 12" below finished grade for all planting areas. Church will re-spread topsoil and install plants.
- 2. Area for topsoil stockpile between building, walks and Linden tree. Provide silt fence around the entire stockpile.
- 3. Existing down spout.
- 4. Concrete footing and foundation. Footing is 8" thick with two #4 rebar, continuous and a minimum of 4' below finished grade. Top of footing has "key" to accept foundation wall. Foundation has two #4 rebar at the top and bottom.

ELEVATION NOTES:

- 1. Limestone wall cap to match existing, flashing full width of wall.
- 2. Existing gutter
- 3. Existing slate roof
- 4. Stone veneer, 4-5" thick, match existing pattern and joints, attach to wall with galvanized ties at 1/3sf. Wall back up is 8x8x16 CMU with #4 rebar at 16"oc the full height, fill cells with mortar that have rebar, paint exposed CMU surfaces with exterior concrete paint with color to match stone.
- Limestone ledge with detailed profile, match existing. 5.
- Limestone base, match existing, flashing at bottom with rope 6. type weeps at 2'OC in bed joint.
- Sealant joint full height of wall. 7.
- Gates. Frame is steel, paint posts and frame to match stone, 7'x 8. 5/4x6" cedar boards attached vertically with metal cap on top.
- 9. Existing downspout.




