The attached ordinance revisions attempt to codify several changes being proposed to our liquor code that are the result of conversations from our business community.

Proprietors have asked for consistency amongst neighboring communities and/or changes in the marketplace that necessitate these changes.

Brewery licenses and the on-site manufacturing of beer, wine and spirits. Code Section 5.08.090 (Class A-4). The City has received interest from various business interests. Two business plans have come forward in the last few weeks and several proprietors have approached us in regards to their interest in St. Charles. To remain both competitive and on the cutting edge of business, staff is recommending changes to our code to allow for this practice.

An Ordinance Amending Title 5, Entitled
“Business Licenses and Regulations”
Chapter 5.08, “Alcoholic Beverages”, 5.08.010, “Definitions”, and 5.08.090,
“License Classifications” of the St. Charles Municipal Code

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Title 5 “Business Licenses and Regulations,” Chapter 5.08 “Alcoholic Beverages”, of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be amended as follows:

5.08.090 – License - Classifications

Local liquor licenses for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor shall be divided into the following classes and sub-classes:

1. **Class A** – Packaged Alcoholic Liquor Licenses Class A licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquor in original packages only and not for consumption on the premises, except as permitted for the Class A-4 license. Class A licenses are divided into the following sub-classes:
 - o **A-1.** Class A-1 licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors in original packages only and not for consumption on the premises. The primary purpose of the premises shall be the retail sale of alcoholic liquor. The premises shall have a minimum gross area of two thousand square feet
 - o

A-4. Class A-4 A licenses shall authorize the retail sale of beer, wine, or spirits for consumption on or off the premises, where brewed, distilled, or fermented on the premises, provided the retail sale of beer or wine for consumption off the premises shall be in original packages only.

SECTION TWO: That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form pursuant to the authority of the City Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
