AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10,  
“VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,” CHAPTER 10.41, “HANDICAPPED PARKING,”  
SECTION 10.41.010, “HANDICAPPED PARKING PLACARDS,”  
AND SECTION 10.41.020, “APPLICATIONS,”  
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE, AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Title 10, “Vehicles and Traffic,” Chapter 10.41, “Handicapped Parking,” Section 10.41.010, “Handicapped Parking Placards,” of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by replacing the existing portion of the section with the following:

10.41.010 – Handicapped Parking Placards

The city shall provide a handicapped motorist placard, which shall be issued to a-St. Charles residents with a temporary disability. ~~handicapped person.~~ This placard shall be the property of such handicapped-disabled individual and may be used only by that person to designate and identify a vehicle not owned by that person or not displaying a handicapped registration plate, as provided for in 625 ILCS 5/11-1301.2 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, to designate when the vehicle is being used to transport said handicapped-disabled person.

Such placard must be prominently displayed by hanging it from the rear-viewrearview mirror so as to be visible through the front windshield. If no rear-viewrearview mirror is available, the placard may be prominently displayed on the dashboard or sun visor so as to be visible through the front windshield.

A placard will be issued for a 90-day period to applicants-St. Charles residents who have a disability that is temporary in nature, and may be renewed once for a like period based upon continued disability. Any person-resident needing more than one (1) renewal is-towill be referred to the Secretary of State’s Office for a handicapped parking placard.

The temporary placards will follow the same design, color, and size specifications as the placards issued by the Illinois Secretary of State, and will have identification of the issuing authority. Temporary placards will be issued for a 90-day period. All individuals with permanent disabilities are-towill be referred to the Illinois Secretary of State’s office.

Section 2. That after the adoption and approval hereof, the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
