Chief Keegan informed the commission that this event will benefit the American Diabetes Association. Chicago Race Management will oversee the event and onsite security will oversee the beer tent, which is sponsored by Alter Brewing. The cycling race route is still being developed. There will be no runners or electric bikes.

Mary Agnes Zellmer of the American Diabetes Association introduced herself. The race was previously held at RiverEdge Park. The liquor supervisors are American Diabetes Association employees. All dispensing of alcohol will be done by Alter Brewing employees. The beer tent will be fenced and adults over age 21 are allowed to enter.

This event was previously approved by the Park District Board and there will be no sales of alcohol. One drink coupon will be provided to each race participant as part of the entry packet.

7. Discussion Regarding a Complaint of Violation and Hearing Notice for Spotted Fox Ale House, located at 3615 E. Main Street, St. Charles.

Commissioner Vitek read the Complaint of Violation for the record.

COMPLAINT OF VIOLATION

NOW COMES the Petitioner, William Hannah, Finance Director of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, and files this Complaint before the Local Liquor Control Commission of the City of St. Charles, Illinois, and states as follows:

1. The Petitioner is the duly appointed Finance Director of the City of St. Charles and as such is charged with the duty of enforcing the laws of the State of Illinois and the ordinances of the City of St. Charles.

2. As of the date hereof, the Licensee, St. Charles Sports, LLC d/b/a Spotted Fox Ale House, by and through its employees, officers and/or agents, committed the following offenses in or upon the licensed premises at 3615 East Main Street, St. Charles, Illinois:

OFFENSE

Failure to timely pay the City alcohol tax and late fee for the tax period ending May 31, 2023, due June 1, 2023, as prescribed by, contrary to and in violation of (i) Section 508.250(23) of the St. Charles Municipal Code, and (ii) Section 3.42.09 of the City Council's Alcohol Tax Ordinance.

OFFENSE

Failure to timely pay the fine and costs imposed by the Order issued and dated June 27, 2023, pursuant to Section 5.08.320 of the St. Charles Municipal Code, served upon Licensee on June 29, 2023, said Order attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

3. As of the date hereof, St. Charles Sports, LLC d/b/a Spotted Fox Ale House is operating under a Class B liquor license and a 1:00 a.m. late night permit issued by the City of St. Charles, said license expiring on April 30, 2024.

4. That the acts detailed in Section 2 of this Complaint of Violation are prohibited and are in violation of and contrary to (i) Sections 5.08.250(23) of the St. Charles Municipal Code, the Liquor Control Act of 1934 and Section 349.09 of the City's Alcohol Tax Ordinance, and (ii) Section 5.08.320 of the St. Charles Municipal Code.

5. That the Licensee, St. Charles Sports, LLC d/b/a Spotted Fox Ale House, is responsible for the acts of its employees, officers and agents and is required to ensure that no violations of state law or ordinances of the City of St. Charles take place on said premises.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner, William Hannah, Finance Director, requests, pursuant to Section 5.08.320 of the St. Charles Municipal Code, that the Local Liquor Control Commission hold a hearing on this matter and take such action against St. Charles Sports, LLC d/b/a Spotted Fox Ale House as the Commission shall deem appropriate under the circumstances.

Attorney Peppers stated that the arraignment form has not yet been received.

Bill Hannah shared that the previous order for Spotted Fox included provisions to ensure that fines would be paid on time. If all payments were made on time through January 2024, half of the fines, equaling \$750, were to be deferred. The May alcohol tax returns due June 30, 2023 were paid on July 3, 2023. The fines from the June 29, 2023 order were to be paid by July 7, 2023 and were paid on July 13, 2023. The fine from the order, including the additional \$750, plus the \$150 alcohol tax late fee, were paid in full on July 13, 2023.

The licensee representative, Marwan Taib, stated that he was unable to pay the fine on time because July is a slow sales month and he could not afford it. Also, the local restaurant manager did not have the correct form. Mr. Taib recapped the alcohol tax fees and late fees paid in 2023. He explained, as was done on June 19, that the business is experiencing financial problems. He elaborated at length about the challenges of his business. He is committed to making the business successful in St. Charles.

Commissioner Vitek assured Mr. Taib that staff follows through to uphold ordinances because it is their duty to do so, equally across all businesses. The City supports Spotted Fox in their efforts to generate more revenue through a modified business plan, as has previously been proposed by Mr. Taib. St. Charles is a business-friendly community and want Spotted Fox to be successful.

At the time of the application, Serena Patel was listed as the General Manager. Serena was fingerprinted by our agency during the initial background investigation and a record check for Serena conducted showing no record. Serena did not have contacts that would preclude her from obtaining a liquor license.

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Serena was fingerprinted by our agency on August 10, 2023. Serena's fingerprints were returned from the Illinois State Police Bureau of Identification, which showed no record.

A check of Serna Patel through Kane County Aegis and the above listed jurisdiction's records showed no negative contacts that would preclude her from obtaining a liquor license.

APPLICANT INTERVIEW:

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On 09/06/2023, I met with Serena at the St. Charles Police Department where she signed a waiver for this background. Serena stated that Main St Liquor LLC DBA Puffs & Pours is purchasing the business, Samp Two Inc., from Pratik Patel. The purchase agreement was dated and signed by all parties on 08/08/2023. Serena stated that she has not purchased any alcohol for the business and would be purchasing the current inventory when the business purchase is complete. Serena stated that the original floor plan will remain the same and no renovations will be conducted. Serena stated that the hours of operation will remain the same. Serena provided the City of St. Charles with a copy of her Certificate of Liability Insurance from MFS Insurances Services Inc. The business is insured for \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 aggregate. Serena advised that once the liquor license is approved she is taking over the lease that was signed on 09/05/2023 by the original owners.



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



OFFENSE

Served alcoholic liquor to a person under the age of 21 years.

3. On or about September 21, 2023, Savway Fine Wines & Spirits was operating under a Class A1 liquor license issued by the City of St. Charles.

4. That the act detailed in Section 2 of this Complaint of Violation is prohibited and is in violation of and contrary to Sections 5.08.250(19)1 and 2 of the St. Charles Municipal Code and the Liquor Control Act of 1934.
