Re: Chums Shrimp Shack

The purpose of this memorandum is to document and forward to your attention the results of the background investigation conducted by members of the St. Charles Police Department concerning the above-mentioned establishment.

As is customary procedure, a detective was assigned this investigation and reviewed the site location/floor plans, the business plan and the corresponding application material. The site location (2115 W. Main Street/former Beef Shack) has been operating as Chums Shrimp Shack since late 2021. The business was recently sold and the new operator is seeking a B-1 license.

While this location has a smaller footprint and not a large amount of seating, a liquor license was held by the former owners. Although the current owner (Luis Rodriguez-Tapia) owns and operates 3-other restaurants in our area; all taco bars (Algonquin, Crystal Lake and Woodstock), three underage sales have taken place in the last 2-years (one in Algonquin and two in Crystal Lake). In each case, a bartender sold alcohol to a minor while police were conducting compliance checks. It is important to note that the owner was not present or directly involved in either of these sales but nonetheless, it his responsibility as an owner/operator to be in operational control of his establishments at all times and this gives me reason to be concerned. While I don't suspect significant liquor sales or minors attempting to consume alcohol at this location as alcohol is ancillary to food sales, I do want to put strict procedures in place ahead of any potential liquor license being issued. That being said, I am recommending The Liquor Commissioner, with approval of the Council, impose the following conditions:

- The purchase of an ID machine to validate and scan all identification cards presented to staff. These machines populate the persons birthdate and scan the barcode for authentication.
- Mandating a manager being present while liquor is being sold.

These provisions would have to be agreed to by the applicant as a condition of a license being granted as the below cited ordinance allows for the city to impose additional restrictions on issuances of license as follows:

5.08.085 - Issuance of licenses and restrictions—Liquor Control Commissioner/City Council

The Local Liquor Control Commissioner may, with the advice and consent of the City Council, and as designated in any license, impose such other and further conditions, as the Local Liquor Control Commissioner and City Council deem necessary. The Local Liquor Control Commissioner may, with the advice and consent of the City Council, permit entertainment as specifically authorized with the issuance of any license.

It should be noted that all 3 other locations the applicant owns/operates are in good standing with each municipality and the State of Illinois.

See the adjoining application material for further information. The police department recommends license approval with the aforementioned stipulations.

IN SUMMARY:

The purpose of this memo is to outline steps taken during the background investigation for a liquor license application. This investigation was done based on the application submitted for a Class (B1) – Restaurant – liquor license for the business Chums Shrimp Shack LLC (DBA: Chums Shrimp Shack) – which is located at 2115 W. Main St., St. Charles, IL 60174.

APPLICANT:

Rodriguez Tapia, Luis G. DOB: 05/11/1985 1441 Glacier Parkway Algonquin, IL 60102 TX: 224-345-1649

APPLICATION:

The application is complete to include: A Certificate of Liability Insurance (\$2,000,000 General Aggregate / \$1,000,000 Each Occurrence), a floor plan (hand drawn), a menu, hours of operation, and a signed Landlord's Acknowledgement and Consent Agreement (lease). Also included, was a copy of an Illinois BASSET Certification for Luis G. Rodriguez (Issued on: 03/04/2024).

On 03/14/24, F.I. Catt fingerprinted Luis as a liquor license applicant. The ISP response had a result of no record on file, and the FBI response revealed no prior arrest data.



PERSONAL INTERVIEW:

On 03/15/24, I met with Luis at the St. Charles Police Department. Luis provided me with his Illinois Driver's License, which I photocopied (see attached). Luis signed waivers so I could conduct this background investigation. During the interview, I learned the following information (in summary and not verbatim):

Luis has lived at his current address (1441 Glacier Parkway, Algonquin, IL 60102) from approximately 2015 to the present. Luis lived at 157 Sioux Avenue in Carpentersville, Illinois from approximately 2010 – 2015.

Luis is a U.S. citizen.

Luis was asked why the move to the St. Charles location and he answered, because it was a good opportunity. Luis wants to expand his business.

There is no liquor inventory at this time.

Luis answered yes, when asked if he was a current or past liquor license holder. Luis owns the following businesses:

- Antigua Mexican Grill (Antigua Mexican Grill LLC.)
 Address: 1500 Carlemont Dr., Crystal Lake, IL 60014
- Antigua Mexican Brunch and Grill (Antigua Mexican Brunch and Grill Inc.)
 Address: 2160 Lake Cook Rd., Algonquin, IL 60102
- Antigua Mexican Grill #3 (Antigua Mexican Grill #3 Inc.)
 Address: 125 E. Calhoun St., Woodstock, IL 60098

In regards to violations:

- Luis explained that in 2023, at the Crystal Lake restaurant, the bartender served alcohol to a minor. Luis had to pay a \$1500 fine and he had his liquor license suspended for 2 weeks.
- Luis explained that in 2022 or 2023, at the Algonquin restaurant, the bartender served alcohol to a minor. Luis had to pay a fine, and then Luis and his staff went to BASSET training.

In regards to the date that he plans to sell liquor, Luis advised as soon as he gets the license.

Chums Shrimp Shack is already open, and no renovations will be done. There will be 6 or 7 employees. Luis advised he will be the onsite manager for now – until he finds a manager.

Utilizing TLOxp, I conducted a business search on each of Luis' (4) businesses, which had the following results (in summary):

• Chums Shrimp Shack LLC:

There were (2) results - a business record and a corporation record. I ran business reports on both of the results (see attached).

• Antigua Mexican Grill LLC:

There were (2) results - a business record and a corporation record. I ran business reports on both of the results (see attached).

Antigua Mexican Brunch and Grill INC.:

There was (1) result - a business record. I ran a business report on the result (see attached).

Antigua Mexican Grill #3 INC.:

There was (1) result - a business record. I ran a business report on the result (see attached).

RECORDS CHECKS:

I conducted records check with the following agencies, and received the following results (in summary):

- Kane County Sheriff's Dept.: No record.
- McHenry County Sheriff's Office: No records of subject.
- Woodstock Police Dept.: "After a thorough search, I have only found one report involving Mr. Rodriguez Tapia, and it was a citation / warning (see attached). I was unable to find any contacts for the business as well."
 - The attached document was for a Traffic Stop on 06/19/2023 for Operate a Motor Vehicle While Using An Electronic Communication Device (23-17417).
- Algonquin Police Dept.: I ultimately received two reports from this agency. Below is a summary of each report:
 - o Report: AL-19-009094 | Burglary From Motor Vehicle:
 - Sonia Alvarez and Luis G. Rodriguez-Tapia are the victims in this case (see narrative for further information).
 - o Report: AL-22-015981 | Unlawful Sale of Alcohol to a Minor:

- On 12/14/22, Ofc. Zahara conducted a covert investigation at 2160
 Lake Cook Rd. (Antigua Mexican Brunch & Grill). The purpose of
 the investigation was to ascertain compliance with local ordinances
 pertaining to the sale of alcohol to minors.
- Det. Sgt. Salazar advised that he observed the minors enter the business and sit at the bar. Det. Sgt. Salazar advised that the bartender, approached the minor's [sic] and asked what they would like to drink. The minor's [sic] requested two bottles of Modelo brand beer. The bartender requested to see the minor's [sic] identification. Det. Sgt. Salazar advised that he observed the bartender grab each of the minor's [sic] vertical Illinois driver's licenses, look at them, and then hand them back to the minors. The bartender grabbed two 12 oz bottles of Modelo brand beer from the cooler, open them up, and then place them in front of the minors. The minors then requested to pay for the beers. The bartender gave the minors their requested check for the beers. The minors gave the bartender \$20.00 US currency and then received change back.
- Ofc. Zahara made contact with the bartender, and advised him of the two Unlawful Sale of Alcohol to a Minor violations that just occurred.
- Ofc. Zahara completed and issued the bartender a Village of Algonquin Municipal Code Violation Citation for two counts of Unlawful Sale of Alcoholic Liquor to a Minor.
- The bartender stated that he was BASSET certified but could not provide his license. Ofc. Zahara conducted a BASSET card lookup on the Illinois Liquor Commission website which revealed that the bartender did not have BASSET certification.
- It should be noted that Ofc. Zahara did not observed [sic] the proof of age sign, the pregnancy warning sign, Village of Algonquin Warning to Persons Under 21 Years of Age Placard, and the State of Illinois Liquor License displayed in plain view with the business.
- <u>Carpentersville Police Dept</u>.: "Good afternoon Robert, Per your request please see below for all police contact found with our department."
 - o The response depicted Tickets & Citations activity (Parking / Ordinance charges, and a Warning), and Case (2016-12407). I later received a copy of report (2016-12407), which is summarized below:

- o Report: 2016-12407 | Disturbance:
 - On 09/24/2016 at approximately 1731 hours officers were dispatched to 157 Sioux Ave. for a disturbance. The caller advised three male Hispanic subjects were outside breaking glass and throwing it on the street.
 - The male subject caller, wanted to remain anonymous, and had called moments before for a Noise Complaint for landscaping noise at the same address of 157 Sioux Ave.
 - Per the Local Ordinance Landscaping Equipment can be used during the day, but not between the hours of 2000 to 0700 (8.16.040(I) Specific Noise Restrictions).
 - Officers arrived on scene for the Disturbance, but there were no male subjects outside of the address or any glass on the roadway.
 - Officer Cervantes spoke with the neighbor at 159 Sioux Ave., who said she had been outside most of the day and had not heard or seen anyone break glass and throw it on the roadway. The neighbor did advise the neighbor at 157 Sioux Ave. was cutting grass, but there was no issue.
 - Officers then spoke with the resident of 157 Sioux Ave., Luis G. Rodriguez, who said he had cut the grass, but there was no issue. Luis then advised he had been having an issue with a resident of 151 Sioux Ave. in the past.
 - Officers then went to 151 Sioux Ave. and spoke with a female subject, who said her husband was the one that had called for a Noise Complaint moments earlier, regarding landscaping noise. Officers know the husband of the female subject, due to prior contacts with him (Gunnar Lakey Jr.). The wife of Gunnar was advised to let him know he needed stop calling 911 and making false police reports.
- <u>Crystal Lake Police Dept</u>.: I ultimately received (3) reports from this agency, which are summarized below:
 - o Report: CL-23-019325 | CL 329-19 SALES OF ALCOHOL:
 - On 09/21/23, the Crystal Lake Police Department conducted a round of liquor compliance checks at predetermined local businesses that carried valid City of Crystal Lake liquor licenses.

- On 09/21/23, CS #23-06 (Confidential Source) entered the front doors of Antiqua Mexican Grill, during regular business hours, and sat at the bar. CS #23-06 requested a Miller Light from the bartender, later identified as Jean Claude Vinasco Rodriguez. Jean Claude poured a Miller Light beer from the tap, and provided the beverage to CS#23-06. CS#23-06 was never asked for any identification.
- Detective Maloney asked Jean Claude if he could tell him what happened. He advised he was busy and did not check the ID of the minor while he served him. Jean Claude was issued a citation.

o Report: CL-22-003812 | INFORMATION FOR POLICE:

- On 03/16/22, Ofc. Harvat assisted Attorney John Cowlin and attempted to serve Luis Rodriguez Tapia, owner of Antigua Mexican Grill (1500 Carelemont Dr), with an order regarding a recent incident in which the business sold liquor to a minor. Ofc. Harvat responded to Antigua and met with a manager, who reported that Luis is on vacation and will not return until a later date in March 2022.
- Ofc. Harvat responded to the business on 03/29/22 and met with Luis. Luis was provided with the order regarding the incident.

o Report: CL-22-002427 | CL 329-19 SALES OF ALCOHOL:

- On 02/22/22, the reporting officer participated in the first round of alcohol compliance checks at local businesses.
- The CS (Confidential Source) and the officer entered Antigua Mexican Restaurant, at which time they walked to the bar area of the restaurant. After sitting down they were greeted by employee Concepcion Hernandez Villanueva. Upon speaking with Concepcion the CS asked to purchase a Miller Lite beer. Concepcion asked the CS for their identification, at which time the CS provided their valid identification card. Concepcion reviewed the card and returned to the CS with an opened, 12oz. Miller Lite beer. The CS provided a \$5 USC bill, at which time Concepcion returned with change and a receipt.
- The officer informed Concepcion that he would be issuing an adjudication citation for Unlawful Sale of Alcohol to a Minor.

A check in New World / Aegis Link for Luis had negative results.

A check in CLEAR for Luis yielded negative results.

SITE VISIT:

On 03/26/24, I responded to Chums Shrimp Shack (2115 W. Main St.) and met with Luis. The physical layout of the business appeared to be consistent with the hand-drawn floor plan included in the application. Luis confirmed that he does not have a blueprint of the floor plan.

In summary, I asked Luis why he did not disclose of the 2022 liquor violation of his Crystal Lake restaurant. Luis explained that he thought I was only asking about the more recent violations. Luis explained that he is paying the Crystal Lake Police to conduct compliance checks with a minor at his Crystal Lake restaurant – once every two months.

This concluded this background investigation.

NARRATIVE

On 09/24/2016 at approximately 1731 hours officers were dispatched to 157 Sioux Ave. for a Disturbance. The caller advised three male Hispanic subjects were outside breaking glass and throwing it on the street.

The male subject caller, wanted to remain anonymous, and had called moments before for a Noise Complaint for landscaping noise at the same address of 157 Sioux Ave. The caller did not leave a name, but a phone number that he used to call 911 was (224) 806-7613. The anonymous caller advised Quadcom dispatch he will be calling every few minutes until an officer responds for the Noise Complaint. Per the Local Ordinance Landscaping Equipment can be used during the day, but not between the hours of 2000 to 0700 (8.16.040(I) Specific Noise Restrictions).

Officers arrived on scene for the Disturbance, but there were no male subjects outside of the address or any glass on the roadway. I then spoke with the neighbor at 159 Sioux Ave., who related the following in summary: The neighbor said she had been outside most of the day and had not heard or seen anyone break glass and throw it on the roadway. The neighbor did advise the neighbor at 157 Sioux Ave. was cutting grass, but there was no issue.

Officers then spoke with the resident of 157 Sioux Ave., Luis G. Rodriguez, who related the following in summary: Luis said he had cut the grass, but there was no issue. Luis then advised he had been having an issue with a resident of 151 Sioux Ave. in the past.

Officers then went to 151 Sioux Ave. and spoke with a female subject, who related the following in summary: She said her husband was the one that had called for a Noise Complaint moments earlier, regarding landscaping noise. Officers know the husband of the female subject, due to prior contacts with him. The husband's name is Gunnar Lakey Jr. The wife of Gunnar was advised to let him know he needed stop calling 911 and making false police reports. Gunnar was not at the residence when officers arrived and the wife advised he had just left.

On August 19, 2019 at 1303 hours Officer Burzynski and I (Officer Randall), were dispatched to 1441 Glacier Parkway for a report of a Burglary to Motor Vehicle.

Upon arrival at the scene we were met by Louis G. Rodriguez-Tapia and Sonia Alvarez. Approximately around 1230 hours this afternoon, Sonia got into her car to go to the store. She noticed her purse was open on the seat, the middle console and glovebox were open. Officer Burzynski and I then conducted a canvas of the surrounding area, we produced the following results:

SUMMARY: On 9/21/23 at 1925 hrs, Jean Claude Vinasco Rodriguez was issued Adjudication Citation #CL00-4163 for city ordinance CL329-19 Sales of Alcohol subsequent to an alcohol compliance check at Antigua Mexican Grill, 1500 Carlemont Dr, Crystal Lake.

NARRATIVE: On 9/21/23, The Crystal Lake Police Department conducted a round of liquor compliance checks at predetermined local businesses that carried valid City of Crystal Lake liquor licenses (See CL-23-018852). In doing so, confidential informants that were under the age of 21 yrs old, were instructed to enter predetermined business' and request to be served and alcoholic beverage. The informants were further instructed to show their current and valid Illinois drivers license or state identification card if asked by the employee. The official advanced funds for this operation were supplied by the Police Department for any money that may have been immediately requested for a sale.

On 9/21/23 at 19245 hrs, CS #23-06 entered the front doors of Antigua Mexican Grill, 1500 Carlemont Dr, Crystal Lake during regular business hours, and sat at the bar. Crystal Lake Commander Miller, working in a capacity of another patron of the business observed CS#23-06 from a distance. CS#23-06 requested a Miller Light from the bartender, later identified as Jean Claude Vinasco Rodriguez. Jean Claude poured a Miller light beer from the tap, and provided the beverage to CS#23-06. CS #23-06 was never asked for any identification. After the service, CS #23-06 stepped out of the business as Commander Miller made contact with Jean Claude Vinasco Rodriguez and restaurant management.

I, Detective Maloney, walked into the business, identified myself, and learned from Commander Miller who the server/violator was, and then began completing Crystal Lake Citation #CL00-4163 for CL329-19 Sales of Alcohol. I asked Jean Claude if he could tell me what happened. He advised he was busy and did not check the ID of the minor while he served him. I educated Jean Claude about checking ID's for those he serves. I issued Jean Claude the above citation with a hearing date of October 25, 2023 at 0830 hrs.

I then met with owner of the business, Luis Rodriguez, and explained the compliance check and adjudication process. He had no further questions.

SUMMARY: On 02-22-2022 Concepcion Hernandez Villanueva was issued an adjudication citation for Unlawful Sale of Alcohol to a Minor subsequent to an alcohol compliance check at Antigua Mexican Restaurant, 1500 Carlemont Drive. Concepcion was advised of the adjudication process as well as the mandatory hearing date of 03-11-2022 at 0830 hours at the City of Crystal Lake. This case should be considered cleared by adjudication citation issued. Body worn camera was utilized during this investigation.

NARRATIVE: On 02-22-2022 I, CL652, participated in the first round of alcohol compliance checks at local businesses (CL-22-002418). I instructed the confidential informant (CS 21-04) to enter the business and attempt to purchase a Miller Lite beer. The CS was instructed to show their valid Illinois identification card if asked by the employee. The official advanced funds for this operation and subsequent transaction were supplied by the police department.

The CS and I entered Antigua Mexican Restaurant, 1500 Carlemont Drive, at which time we walked to the bar area of the restaurant. After sitting down we were greeted by employee Concepcion Hernandez Villanueva. Upon speaking with Concepcion the CS asked to purchase a Miller Lite beer. Concepcion asked the CS for their identification, at which time the CS provided their valid identification card. Concepcion reviewed the card and returned to the CS with an opened, 12 oz. Miller Lite beer. Through my previous training and experience I observed the bottle to be an alcoholic beverage. The CS provided a \$5 USC bill, at which time Concepcion returned with change and a receipt. The CS provided me with the change and receipt at which time I advised the CS to exit the restaurant and wait in the vehicle.

After the CS exited the store Detective Duncan entered Antigua in a marked Crystal Lake Police Vest. I informed Concepcion that we were conducting alcohol compliance checks, in which she had served an alcoholic beverage to a minor under the age of 21. Concepcion stated that she did not speak English, in which I advised that I was bilingual and would provide all information in Spanish. It should be noted that our conversation was spoken entirely in Spanish. I advised Concepcion that she had sold to a minor, in which I confirmed that she checked the identification before still providing the CS with a drink. Concepcion advised that she understood. I informed Concepcion that I would be issuing an adjudication citation for Unlawful Sale of Alcohol to a Minor. I then informed Concepcion of the adjudication process as well as the mandatory hearing date of 03-11-2022 at 0830 hours. Concepcion stated she understood and did not have any further questions at this time. I further informed Concepcion stated she understood.

A copy of the receipt was later placed into evidence.

This case should be considered cleared by adjudication citation issued.

SALE AND ASSIGNMENT OF OWNERSHIP OF CHUMS SHRIMP SHACK, LLC

This Agreement is dated this 1st day of March, 2024,(the "Closing") for the sale of all the membership interests in CHUMS SHRIMP SHACK, LLC, an Illinois limited liability company ("Company") by JENNIFER SOLARE ("Seller") to LUIS G. RODRIGUEZ ("Buyer").

- 1. <u>Purchase Price.</u> The Purchase Price is \$40,000 in consideration of Seller's assignment of all of her 100% membership interest in the Company to Buyer (see Exhibit C, attached hereto and made a part hereof), \$20,000 of which will have been paid upon signature and acceptance of the letter of intent dated February 28, 2024 (the "Letter of Intent"), and the balance of \$20,000 shall be paid at Closing.
- 2. <u>Terms and Conditions</u>. The terms and conditions specified in the Letter of Intent attached as Exhibit B hereto, are incorporated into this Agreement and made a part hereof with such changes or clarifications as required stated separately below.

3. Changes and Clarifications as Required.

- (a) The company is a limited liability company and has membership interests, not shares of stock. It is the membership interests of Seller which are being assigned by this agreement to Buyer as memorialized in Exhibit C.
- (b) All equipment, furniture owned by the Landlord or the tenant (Seller) is transferred with the transfer of the lease and sale of the membership interests, and such items are listed in Exhibit A. Buyer has had the time and conducted due diligence and is aware of any issues with the equipment, furnishings and other items in the restaurant and used in the operations of the restaurant. ALL ITEMS ON SCHEDULE B ARE SOLD "AS IS" and "WHERE IS". EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS AGREEMENT, THE LISTED ITEMS ARE BEING SOLD TO BUYER OR TRANSFERRED AS PART OF THE LEASE TRANSFER "AS IS," "WHERE IS" AND "WITH ALL FAULTS" AND SELLER MAKES NO REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY, WHETHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AS TO THE PHYSICAL CONDITION OF THE ACQUIRED ASSETS, THEIR VALUE, DESIGN, MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, AS TO THE QUALITY OF THE ACQUIRED ASSETS OR AS TO THE ABSENCE OF LATENT OR OTHER DEFECTS, WHETHER OR NOT DISCOVERABLE.
- (c) Seller represents that any outstanding vendor and utilities invoices shall be paid on or prior to the closing date or pro-rated if received after closing for any period prior to the closing date.



From: James Keegan, Chief of Police Re: 2024/25 Late-Night Permits

Pursuant to city code, I have reviewed the attached late-night permit request for FY24-25.

Each permit request was vetted by the respective city department to ensure compliance with fees, payments, permits, etc. As a means to identify our city code as it pertains to late night permitting, I've included the attached ordinance language as a frame of reference. Please see below:

City Ordinance/5.08.095 Late Night Permit

- C. Annually, the liquor license renewal process shall commence on the first city business day in February. Current license holders shall submit a renewal application and include any requested changes. For those license holders applying for a new or renewing a late-night permit, they are required to specify whether they are applying for the 1:00 a.m. or the 2:00 a.m. permit. In addition, any new or renewal applications shall include a current business concept outlining the operations intended during the late-night permit term of one year, in conjunction with the liquor license to be issued on May 1 of the same year. Failure to provide a timely renewal application or late-night permit application may result in a delay in issuing said license and permit by May 1 of that year.
- D. Upon receipt of a new or renewal application, the Liquor Commissioner shall cause a review of the previous year license application to determine whether there have been any changes noted with regard to ownership, management or business concept. This application shall be forwarded to:
 - 1. Chief of Police
 - 2. Fire Department

- 3. Finance Department
- 4. Community Development Department
- E. The city departments indicated in Section D will review any infractions of any city code, reflecting negatively on the license holder that should be taken into account by the Liquor Control Commission and City Council. That information shall be returned to the Liquor Commissioner for review. In addition, the Chief of Police shall cause a review of the police related activity which will support a recommendation from the Chief of Police on whether the late-night permit shall be issued and whether a 1:00 a.m. or 2:00 a.m. closing is recommended based on the permit application. The Chief of Police shall forward the recommendation to the Liquor Commissioner.
- F. Any application and recommendation for a new or renewal of a late-night permit, shall be reviewed by the Liquor Control Commission. Based on this review the Local Liquor Commissioner shall make a recommendation on issuance to City Council. An applicant for a late-night permit shall have the opportunity to be present and provide input on said application, prior to the Liquor Control Commission making a recommendation. Late night permits and renewals of late-night permits shall be issued by the Liquor Commissioner with the advice and consent of the City Council.
- G. Any new liquor license application where a new late-night permit is also applied for shall follow the same review process as outlined in paragraphs B, C, D, E and F of this Chapter.
- H. Notice of Violation Process-Late Night Permit. If during a liquor license year, May 1 through April 30, where a liquor license holder has been issued a late-night permit and a notice of violation is issued by the Liquor Control Commissioner, the Liquor Control Commission shall hold a hearing on the matter. The liquor license with the late-night permit shall be given notice of the purpose, date, time and location of the hearing in a similar manner to a liquor license violation. The matter will be heard before the Liquor Control Commission in the same manner as any license violation. The Liquor Control Commission shall provide advice and consent to the Local Liquor Control Commissioner, who shall make a final decision on the matter.
- I. Cause to Reduce Hours, Revoke Late Night Permit or Not Issue Late Night Permit. In the event that a liquor license holder, has applied for or been issued a late-night permit, and has demonstrated circumstances giving reason to review whether that late-night permit shall be issued, reduced in hours or revoked, the Liquor Control Commission shall receive input from these city departments:
 - 1. Finance Department as it relates to unpaid fees, utilities or city taxes;

- 2. Fire Department as it relates to repetitive fire code violations affecting health and safety;
- 3. Community Development Department, Building and Code Enforcement Division as it relates to building code violations;
- 4. Police Department as it relates to repetitive calls for service that are indicative of underage patrons, over service of patrons, or liquor license violations affecting the safety of the general public where the licensee is not taking proactive measures to abate the problems;
- 5. Other departments with applicable information.
- J. The license holder shall have the opportunity to respond to information in a public hearing prior to any action being taken, by the Liquor Control Commission before sending any recommendation to City Council.
- K. The Liquor Control Commission may recommend the issuance or denial of a requested late-night permit for 1:00 a.m. or 2:00 a.m., or reduction in hours based on cause to the City Council for final decision.

I recommend in favor of the aforementioned requests as identified in the attached spreadsheet. A total of 27-busineses are seeking late-night permits; 13/1 a.m. permits and 14/2 a.m. permits.

As always, I stand ready to answer any questions or concerns you might have in reference to my recommendation. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and consideration in this matter.
