## Executive Summary:

Ryder Truck Rental Inc. (Ryder) has applied for a building permit to construct a truck maintenance facility on the property at 510 S . Tyler Road. The property was formerly a lumber yard and a few years ago this site was contemplated as a golf entertainment facility.

The site is comprised of 2 parcels under one common owner. The south parcel is included in Special Service Area 7 (SSA 7) and the north parcel is outside of SSA 7.

The main function of SSA 7 is to fund the maintenance of the City owned regional detention pond directly adjacent to the Ryder site. Properties within SSA 7 may utilize the regional detention pond to satisfy stormwater requirements.

During the civil engineering design process, the applicant inquired as to the feasibility of enlarging SSA 7 to include their entire parcel. This would allow Ryder to utilize the regional detention pond for their entire site, eliminating the need for on-site stormwater detention. Staff decided to consider this proposal under the stipulation that the applicant's engineer could prove that the overall stormwater flows from the regional pond would be reduced, resulting in an overall downstream stormwater improvement. The applicant proposed to accomplish this by performing grading modifications to the top of the detention pond berm, resulting in an increase in the capacity of the pond.

After careful review of the applicants engineering plans and stormwater model by Staff and WBK Engineering, Staff confirmed that stormwater flows from the site will indeed be reduced by a significant amount, ranging from a $5 \%$ reduction during a 2 -year storm and a $27 \%$ reduction during a 100 -year storm. This results in a significant downstream stormwater benefit while at the same time allowing the proposed Ryder facility to utilize the regional detention pond.

State statute requires the City Council pass an ordinance proposing the enlargement of the SSA and set a date for public hearing, which may be held no sooner than 60 days following passage of the ordinances. That hearing is being held August 15, 2016. Following this public hearing, the City Council can pass an ordinance formally enlarging the SSA no sooner than 60 days following the close of the

| public hearing. The earliest this could occur is the City Council meeting on October 17, 2016. |

# City of St. Charles, Illinois <br> Ordinance No. 2016-M- <br> $\qquad$ 

## An Ordinance Proposing the Enlargement of Special Service Area No. 7 in the City of St. Charles, Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois, and Providing for a Public Hearing and Other Procedures in Connection Therewith (510 S. Tyler Rd.)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of St. Charles, Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Authority to Establish and Enlarge Special Service Area. Special Service Areas are established pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, in force July 1, 1971, which provides:
"(1) The General Assembly may not deny or limit the power of home rule units** *
(2) to levy or impose additional taxes upon areas within their boundaries in the manner provided by law for the provision of special services to those areas and for the payment of debt incurred in order to provide those special services."
and are established pursuant to provisions of the "Special Service Area Tax Law", as amended (35 ILCS 200/27 et seq. (the "Act")). The boundaries of a special service area may be enlarged pursuant to the procedures set forth in Section 200/27-50 of the Act.

Section 2: Findings. This City Council finds:
A. That the City Council previously established a Special Service Area No. 7 by Ordinance No. 1990-M-1, as amended by Ordinances No. 1990-M-20.
B. It is in the public interest that the Special Service Area No. 7 which has been previously created be considered for enlargement to contain the area hereinafter described for the purposes set forth herein.
C. That said area as enlarged is compact and contiguous and constitutes a commercial area in the City of St. Charles.
D. That the area proposed to be added to the special service area represents less than 5\% of the assessed valuation of the current area as determined by the Clerk of the County of Kane (the current area having a current assessed value of \$22,786,694 and the area to be added having a current assessed value of $\$ 431,711$ ).
E. That the area as enlarged, including the property being added, is generally zoned for manufacturing and all of said area including the property being added will benefit specially from the municipal services to be provided in the nature of the maintenance of retention/ detention ponds by mowing, removal of debris and flotsam, maintenance of elevations and contours, removal of siltation and correction of erosion. The proposed municipal services are unique and in addition to the municipal services provided to the City of St. Charles as a whole, and it is,
therefore, in the best interest of the City of St. Charles that the levy of special taxes against said area including the property being added for the services to be provided be considered.

Section 3: Public Hearing -Tax Rate. That a public hearing shall be held on the 15th day of August, 2016, at 6:45p.m., in the City Council Chambers, 2 East Main Street, St. Charles, Illinois, to consider enlarging Special Service Area No. 7 of the City of St. Charles by adding the territory described in the notice set forth in Section 4 hereof. At the hearing there will also be considered a levy of an annual tax of not to exceed an annual rate of $0.1 \%$ (or $\$ .10$ per $\$ 100.00$ ) of the assessed value, as equalized, of the taxable real property in the territory to be added to the territory of Special Service Area No. 7, said tax to be in addition to all other taxes provided by law.

Section 4: Notice of Hearing. Notice of the hearing shall be published at least once not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the public hearing in one or more newspapers of general circulation in the City of St. Charles. In addition, notice by mailing shall be given by depositing said notice in the United States Mail addressed to the person or persons whose names the general taxes for the last preceding year were paid on each lot, block, tract or parcel of land lying within the territory proposed to be added to the territory of Special Service Area No. 7. Said notice shall be mailed not less than ten (10) days prior to the time set for public hearing. In the event taxes for the last preceding year were not paid, the notice shall be sent to the person or persons last listed on the tax rolls prior to that year as the owner(s) of said property. The notice shall be substantially in the following form:

Section 5: Map. A map of the proposed territory to be added as well as the current Special Service Area No. 7 is appended hereto and is on file in the Office of the City Clerk and available for public inspection.

Section 6. That this Ordinance shall become effective from passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
