

Visioning Workshop

For the City of St. Charles Comprehensive Plan

This hands-on workshop invites community members to share their vision for the future of St. Charles and will help lay the groundwork for developing detailed plan recommendations.

What is a Comprehensive Plan?

The Comprehensive Plan serves as a “road map” for the City over the next 10 to 15 years, guiding planning and policies governing land use and development, transportation and mobility, open space and environmental features, community facilities and infrastructure, sustainability, and community identity. It provides a foundation for decision-making based on community consensus and vision, existing conditions, and future opportunities.

Where are we at in the process?

The project kicked off with a Community Workshop on Aug. 31, followed by three neighborhood workshops and a business workshop. The project is now in the Vision, Goals and Objectives phase, where the overall vision for the City and the Downtown will take shape. Based on the vision that emerges, along with an existing conditions analysis and feedback from the recently held workshops, Preliminary Goals and Objectives will be prepared.

How to participate:

Everyone is welcome to attend the workshop. Additionally, community members are encouraged to continue offering input through the project website or on the green comment cards that were distributed at past workshops. Resident and Business Questionnaires which reflect feedback from earlier workshops also have been posted to the website. In addition, the interactive Planning Mapper tool on the website allows detailed comments to be posted on a map of the City.
