

**LIQUOR COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES
April 12, 2011**

A meeting of the St. Charles Liquor Commission was held on Tuesday, April 12, 2011 in the City Council Chambers. The meeting commenced at 4:40 p.m.

PRESENT: Mayor DeWitte, Attorney Tom Good, Police Chief Jim Lamkin, and Tina Nilles.

The meeting was called to order to address a liquor violation against Scotland Yard for allegedly over serving a female such that the victim required transport to the hospital with apparent alcohol poisoning. Scotland Yard was order immediate suspension on April 5, 2011 to close down their place of business for seven (7) days (until today). Attorney Good consulted with the attorney representing Scotland Yard and earlier today licensee surrendered liquor license along with a letter to the Mayor stating:

As of today, April 12, 2011, due to the 7-day closure and impending hearing, I Robert W. Dresmal (President, owner and operator of Gen-Dre Investments), do hereby surrender my city liquor license #007160 in the name of Gen-Dre Investments valid from May 1, 2010 to April 30, 2011. I understand that surrendering this license will result in Gen-Dre Investment Co. no longer being able to sell alcoholic beverages of any kind at the 301 W Main Street location in St. Charles.

Letter and license of Gen-Dre Investments d/b/a Scotland Yard was accepted. Tina will notify the Illinois State Commissioner of this business no longer being in operation in the City of St. Charles.

Meeting adjourned at 4:40 p.m.
