**E. Additional Items from Mayor, Council, Staff, or Citizens**

- Alder. Rogina

We received notification today that 15<sup>th</sup> Street would not be used for Illinois Central Buses. My question to staff is what's the plan through December 31. What's going to happen now?

**Chief Lamkin**

We have regular meetings and communication with the staff people there. We met this morning and showed a staff member the route that we are recommending. North on Randall, west on Dean St. to Peck Road, south on Peck Road. For buses going East on Route 64, they would go left there. For buses continuing East to Route 38 would be directed back to Randall road or continue South on Peck Road to Route 38 and go east. That was received very well. We provided them with maps to give to drivers in the morning. They will make an announcement to drivers. They have been informed if they do not follow this route the drivers will get traffic tickets. They have asked us to do this.

**Alder. Rogina**

So it is your recommendation that the buses do not go east on Dean St.

**Chief Lamkin**

We did propose previously that they can go to 9th and take a left there. Their dispatcher said they try to avoid those situations because there is no signal there. We have done some time studies last week. After doing time studies, it really doesn't save any time. It is safer for them to use the signalized intersections for safety.

**Alder. Rogina**

As of December 31, they will all be going out on 17th Street, is that correct.

**Brian Townsend**

That is the plan to get them access to Main St.

**Alder. Rogina**

My request is for the Planning and Development chair a notice of a public hearing. I would like to discuss the 250 feet notification. I believe that there are a lot of people reacting after the fact because they know what was going to happen. I would like to discuss this.

**Mayor DeWitte**

I am not sure I understand the request, are you asking for another public hearing or the public hearing process.

**Alder. Rogina**

No I am not asking for another public hearing. I want to know if there is any desire, interest or discussion about changing the ordinance as it currently is.

**Mayor DeWitte**

I will direct this to Mr. Gorski.

**Gery Gorski**

I don't know if this is legal or practical notification? Ray is the point practical or legal preconditions.

**Alder. Rogina**

No, right now the ordinance reads, as I understand it, that if there is going to be a change in the use, classification of the ordinance. There would be a public hearing to discuss that change. That notification has to go out to people who reside within 250 feet of the change. My thought is that this should be broader. My question is how we go about the process into changing the ordinance.

**Gerry Gorski**

So you are interested in asking the committee to change the ordinance to broaden the notification. This doesn't affect the hearing that has already been conducted under the gallery of the notices that were given under the ordinance that was enforced at the time. It is prospective only, subject for discussion.

**Alder. Rogina**

I am asking that this be put on the agenda at the P&D meeting.

**Brian Townsend**

Point of clarification, the notice applies to any property owner within 250 feet not based on who resides there.

**Alder. Carrignan**

What are the ramification of expanding the number from 250 feet?

**Gerry Gorski**

If could be more costly.

**Brian Townsend**

It puts more burden on the applicant/property owner for the City it is cost neutral.

**Alder. Lewis**

It seems to be an issue in the morning. What about when the buses return?

**Chief Lamkin**

It is not just the morning situation. They have four time periods throughout the day when buses go out and return. Our direction to them, all of their routing should change to the way we described it. It includes the PMs. It is not so much of an issue with the returning buses.

**Alder. Carrignan**

I was going down Main Street and noticed buses turning left on 15th.

**Chief Lamkin**

We have made it very clear that the drivers will be subject to citations
