Staff has met with ComEd monthly since our last update in October 2011.

There has been 1 momentary outage since our last report.

The momentary outage was on December 30, 2011 at 6:29 AM. The outage impacted some customers on the east side of the city, generally north of Main St, such as Royal Fox and Fox Chase Blvd. Areas. The cause of the outage was a burned line tap on the ComEd line. This problem was repaired the same day as the outage.

There were no ComEd related outages in November or January to date.

City staff continues to discuss long term reliability with ComEd. Lighting performance upgrades are underway on the line serving Peck Road and Prairie Street subs. ComEd has decided to change the configuration of the line serving the City Hall sub. This change is expected to lessen the impact of tree contact in the area north of the Q-Center. The completion date for this upgrade is yet to be determined, but is expected before next summer.

The next ComEd meeting is scheduled for February 8, 2012.
