The Illinois Department of Transportation applied for and was awarded a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant for the improvement of the traffic signals along IL 64 from 7th St. to 7th Ave. This project would include the replacement and upgrading of the existing IDOT traffic signals along this section of IL 64.

Some of the anticipated improvements with the traffic signal upgrades included the installation of pedestrian countdown signals and the replacement of the City's EVP Emergency Response System.

Currently there is a cost sharing agreement with IDOT for all of the proposed signals within this corridor. Based on that agreement, the City would be obligated for a percentage of the total costs (refer to attached exhibit for percentage specifics). Staff has been working closely with IDOT on this program and believes that the proposed improvements will help to improve the safety of both vehicle and pedestrian movements along this corridor. For these reasons staff recommends that approval of the IDOT agreement for this HSIP grant program.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the STATE, in order to facilitate the free flow of traffic and insure safety to the motoring public as part of the Highway Safety Improvement Program is desirous of improving the existing signalized intersection(s) on IL RTE 64 (Main St) by modernizing the traffic signals at IL RTE 64 (Main St) at 7th St.; at 3rd St.; at IL 31 (2nd St); at 1st St.; at 1st Av.; at IL 25 (5th Av) and at 7th Av., (to be known as STATE Section 1288-R-2 TS) and by performing all other work necessary to complete the improvement in accordance with the plans and specifications; and,

WHEREAS, the CITY is desirous of said improvement in that same will be of immediate benefit to the CITY, and permanent in nature; and,

WHEREAS, the intersection(s) of IL RTE 64 (Main St) at 7th St.; at 3rd St.; at IL 31 (2nd St); at 1st St.; at1st Av.; at IL 25 (5th Av) and at 7th Av., lies within the corporate limits of the CITY.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The STATE agrees to prepare plans and specifications, receive bids, award the contract, furnish engineering inspection during construction, and cause the improvement to be built in accordance with the plans, specifications, and contract. The STATE also agrees to pay all construction and engineering costs subject to reimbursement by the CITY as hereinafter stipulated.
- 2. The CITY agrees to approve the plans and specifications by letter or resolution prior to the STATE advertising for the work to be performed hereunder.
- 3. It is mutually agreed that the proportional participation for the construction costs and engineering costs of this improvement shall be as follows:

*The **installation** of new EVP Equipment at the intersections of: IL RTE 64 (Main St) at 7th St.; at 3rd St.; at IL 31 (2nd St); at 1st St.; at 1st Av.; at IL 25 (5th Av) and at 7th Av., is the Responsibility of the CITY OF ST. CHARLES and is estimated to be \$6,000.00 per intersection (+15% engineering) for a total of \$48,300.00.

- 5. It is mutually agreed that the CITY will reimburse the STATE in an amount equal to the CITY'S share of the actual cost as determined in accordance with Item #3 above. It is mutually agreed that upon award of the contract for this improvement, the CITY will pay to the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois, in a lump sum from any funds allotted to the CITY. An amount equal to 80% of its obligation incurred under this Agreement, and will pay to the said Department the remainder of its obligation (including any non-participating costs for FA projects) in a lump sum, upon completion of the project based upon final costs.
- 6. Upon acceptance by the Department of Transportation of the traffic signal improvement included herein, the financial responsibility for maintenance and electrical energy for the operation of the traffic signals shall remain as outlined in the Master Agreement executed between the City of St. Charles and the Department of Transportation on July 1, 2011.
- 7. The actual maintenance will be performed by the STATE with its own forces or through an ongoing contractual agreement.
- 8. Payment by the STATE of any or all of its share of maintenance and energy costs is contingent upon the STATE receiving adequate funds in its annual appropriation.
- 9. The STATE retains the right to control the sequence of timing on the traffic signals.
- 10. The STATE will be responsible for maintenance of lane line and median line markings. The CITY will be responsible for maintenance of crosswalk and stop line markings under their jurisdiction.
- 11. The CITY agrees to exercise its franchise right to cause private utilities to be relocated at no expense to the STATE.
